Sports - \$400

- Heisman Trophy Winner, winner of 2 National Championships, and remains one of the best college football players ever.

- Who is Johnny Rodgers?



Sports - \$500

- Despite having a masters degree from Creighton University, he was not allowed to teach or coach in the Omaha Public Schools, so he created the largest P.E. class in North Omaha.
- Who is Josh Gibson?



Leadership - \$100

- Former Governor of Alabama and a chief spokesperson for segregation who came to Omaha as a third-party candidate for the presidency on March 4, 1968.

- Who is George Wallace?



Leadership - \$200

- He was a Creighton University law student and barber who became the longest serving state senator in Nebraska representing North Omaha for 46 years.

- Who is Ernie Chambers?



Leadership - \$300

- This former Hollywood actor grew up in North Omaha.

- Who is John Beasley?



Leadership - \$400

- They used federal funds to create the North Freeway (Hwy 75 North) demolishing more than 1,000 homes and businesses between 30th and 24th Street in the heart of North Omaha.
- Who were the Omaha City Planners?



Leadership - \$500

- The families whose homes were demolished to build the North Freeway were moved to other parts of Omaha. This is called ...

South Omaha - \$100

- An employment magnet for Southern Black people.
- What are the Omaha Union Stockyards?



South Omaha - \$200

- Cows, hogs, and sheep
- What were three stockyard animals for sale at the Livestock Exchange?



South Omaha - \$300

- These South Omaha businesses provided good pay for Black people if they could “stomach” the work.
- What are the Packing Houses?



South Omaha - \$400

- The city Omaha eclipsed to become the busiest livestock market in 1955.

South Omaha - \$500

- The era in which the stockyards encouraged Southern Black people to “migrate” North.

- What is the “Great Migration”?



Racism - \$100

- When Bob Boozer and Black friends got out of the Omaha Downtown YMCA pool in the 1950s, this happened.

Racism - \$200

- This professional athlete was not allowed to purchase a lot in Northwest Omaha to build on because he was Black.

Racism - \$300

- Up until this year when the Fair Housing Act was passed, White property owners were legally allowed to refuse selling or renting to Black people.
- What is 1968? Federal 1968. State of Nebraska 1969.



Racism - \$400

- These laws gave business owners, theaters, restaurants, and even doctors permission to refuse service to Black people.
- What are the Jim Crow Laws?



Racism - \$500

- The Black man who was hanged, drug down the streets, and then burned in downtown Omaha on September 28, 1919.

North Omaha - \$100

- The park where North Omaha kids would get together to play “touch” football.

- In the film, Dan Goodwin personally coined Omaha this because of its blatant racist behaviors.

- What is “family structure”?



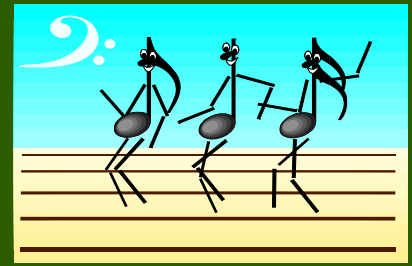
