- **Unity One-** (Ramirez, President and Hartnell, VP)-is an all-girl service organization designed to build community while serving local nonprofit organizations and local elementary schools. They have 74 members, each having a goal of serving at least 10 hours each semester. As of present, the organization has already participated in over 50 events this school year. Two of which they spearheaded: Thanksgiving Food Drive and Donation collection for the Drake House. Both service projects were a success.

AHS indoor Color Guard is competing in nationals for the 1st time. Our Robotics is making it to state for the first time. We are hosting a Track Meet this weekend. We have several students qualifying for sectionals in track and "state" hopefuls.

Scheifflee shared that the school received 2 surpluses. It was expected. Mr. Dice and team are working on filling vacancies. He also pointed out that it is better to hire strategy rather than inheriting personnel. A few staff members have shared their goals for pursuing new opportunities.

Scheifflee also shared that the school store should be finished before school closes in May.
