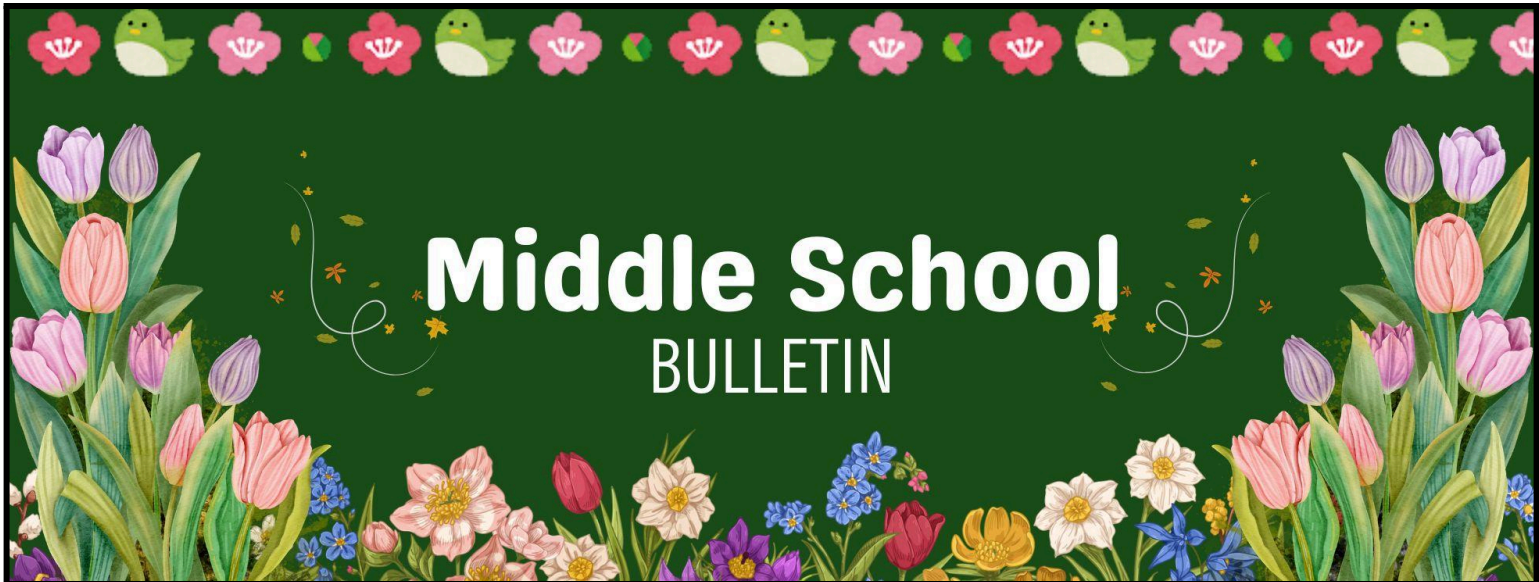

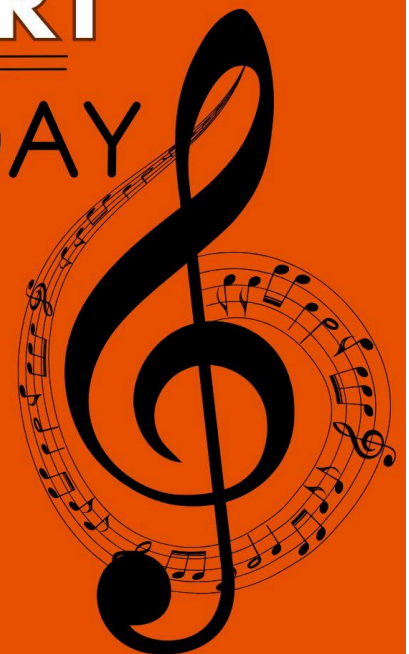

3rd quarter



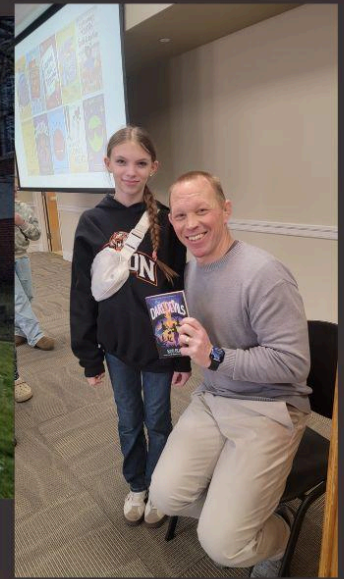
