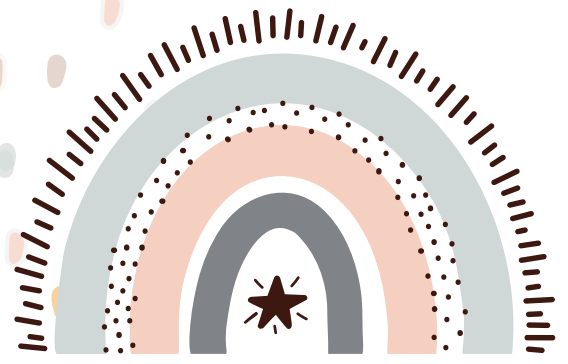

What We Are Learning



7th Grade - Texas History students will start off with a unit test over The Age of Oil Era in Texas. From there we will combine Unit 10 (Texas During the Great Depression and World War II - 1929-1950) and Unit 11 (Civil Rights and Conservatism Bring Changes - 1950-Present).

8th Grade: Students will review for the upcoming Social Studies STAAR test by revisiting all previously covered units and practicing test-taking strategies to build confidence and preparedness.
