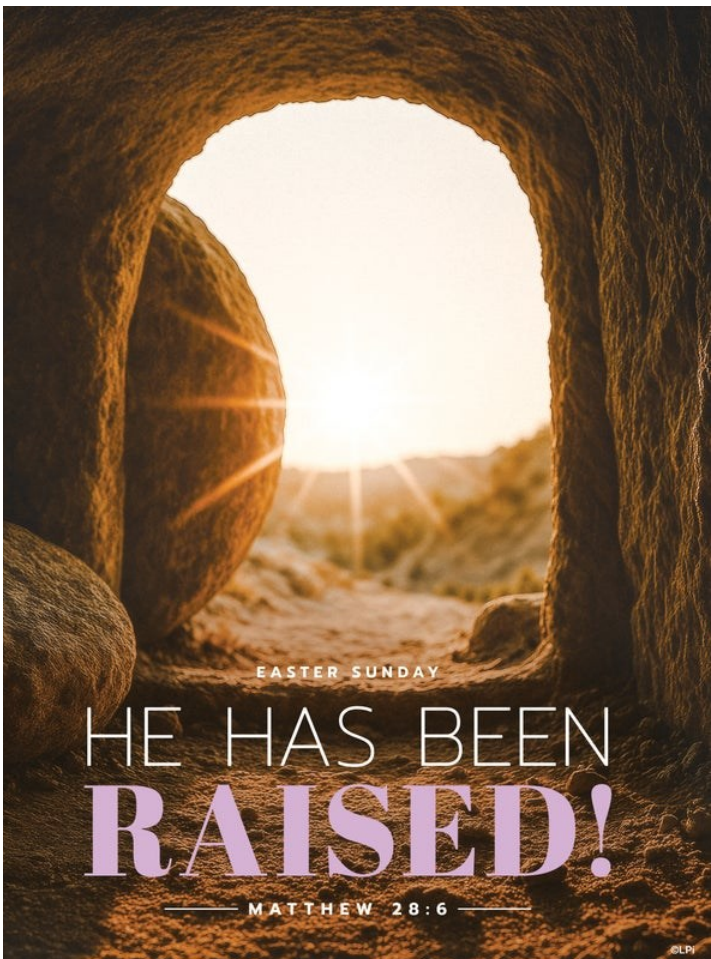

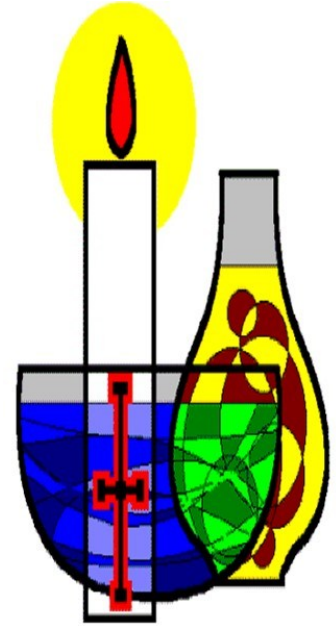

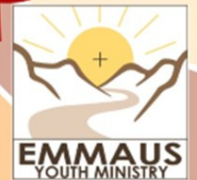
Eucharistic Pilgrimage
