Warm Weather Clothing

Keep in mind the District dress code when dressing your children for school now that we hope winter is almost gone. Here are some common questions about the dress code:

Are shorts allowed? Yes, shorts are allowed, pending weather. Please make sure they are an appropriate length for school. Use common sense when choosing your child's shorts, or when older students are making their own choices.

Can my child wear a tank top? Wearing tank tops is allowed for girls or boys as long as the straps are 4 inches wide for adult sizes and 3 inches wide for youth sizes. If the straps are smaller than 4 inches, your child will be asked to put a different shirt on.

What kind of shoes does my child need? Students in grades 4K-5 have gym every week. They need to wear tennis shoes for gym. Any other shoes are acceptable as long as they are safe for the student to wear. Do not wear flip flops on phy ed days! Some flip-flops are okay for the beach, but don't work well for playing outside during recess, and can be dangerous!
