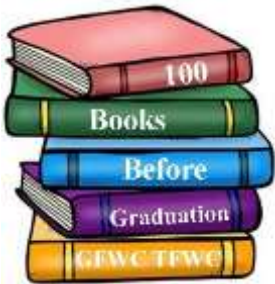

100 BOOKS BEFORE GRADUATION

This is becoming a popular initiative across the country. Every community has its own needs and variations, but the goal of the GFWC Thompson Falls Woman's Club is to stimulate a love for reading.



SCOPE OF COVERAGE

Ages 9th through 12th grades. The challenge is offered to any children residing in Sanders County regardless of what public, private or online high school program they utilize for their education.

ENROLLMENT

Students would enroll with a parent/guardian's approval in person or via email through the Thompson Falls Public Library. A reading log will be kept for each student at the Thompson Falls Public Library. Books must be reading level appropriate and may be a classroom assignment, but not the class textbook. The student may report a completed book in person or via email with a form stating the title, author, format, and signature of a parent, guardian, teacher, or school counselor. Print, Ebooks, audiobooks, or another format are all acceptable.

QUARTERLY DRAWING

Every book read will earn one entry into the quarterly drawing. The winner for the books read January – March winner will be drawn at the April meeting; April - June winner will be drawn in July at the library; June - August winner will be drawn at the September meeting; September – December will be drawn at the club's January meeting. There will be one top prize winner for a \$25 gift card and one \$15 gift card winner each quarter from all the entries. The winner will be offered a choice of online or physical gift card. When notified, the drawing winner has two weeks to respond and make arrangements to claim the prize, otherwise an alternate winner will be selected.

A special \$100 gift card will be awarded to each student reaching 100 books before graduation.
