During April we will focus on the Resiliency Characteristic of Mentorship – giving or asking for support, guidance, training or expertise. In Kindergarten through 2nd grade, children are learning to understand the importance of asking for help, recognizing characteristics of a helpful person, and practicing decision-making during daily activities. In 3rd through 5th grade, children are learning the importance of helping others at school and in the community, understanding when to ask someone he or she trusts for support and guidance, and practicing decision-making while treating others with respect. We encourage you to partner with us in reinforcing the importance of Mentorship at home by having open conversations and setting positive examples. You are the most important person in your child's life, and research shows that parental involvement significantly improves a student's school performance. Talk with your child about what is happening in school by showing interest in what they are learning and in their academic progress. In addition, make sure your child is getting enough sleep. Elementary-aged children should get at least 10-11 hours of sleep each night. Finally, be supportive by praising extra effort and celebrating achievements!
