WHAT NOT TO PACK

- X Cell phones, walkie-talkies, 2-way radios, computers
- X Hand-held games, TVs or DVD players, PlayStation, Xbox or similar devices
- X Expensive cameras
- X Valuable jewelry
- X Roller skate shoes, roller blades, hoverboards
- X Candy, gum, food, or beverage of any kind
- X Super-soakers, water balloons, squirt guns, etc.
- X Pocket knives, or any item that could be used as a weapon
- X Explosives or fireworks of any sort
- X Medication or drugs of any sort that are not listed on the Health Form
- X Expensive clothing requiring special washing
- X T-shirts with inappropriate language and/or advertising cigarettes or alcohol
- X Shoes or sandals with heels higher than two inches
- X Anything that would deeply upset your child if lost or damaged

LOST AND FOUND

At the end of each session, we will send out any LABELED item that fits into a large envelope. For larger items, you will be offered the option to pick them up at Wilshire Boulevard Temple or to have us ship it to you and charge the card you have on file for the cost.

We keep a "Be On The Lookout" list. If you notice that you are missing something, please email a detailed description to janine@wbtcamps.org. If you realize your camper accidentally brought home something that you didn't send him or her to camp with, please let us know.
