- Share the latest updates on the New High School project



New High School Update

- The Siteworks 1 permit was issued on March 30th and construction activities have commenced.
- Activities included installing temporary perimeter/construction fencing, surveying clearing limits, tagging trees that will be saved and installing Temporary Erosion & Sediment Control (TESC) measures.
- Construction support materials such as storage containers, forklifts, porta-potties and hygiene stations have started arriving on the site.

New High School Update

- The team continues to work with the City of Issaquah to obtain remaining permits including the building, garage, site work, retaining walls, and SE 43rd Way Right-of-Way (ROW).
- The team also continues to coordinate with the City of Sammamish on the 228th Ave SE Right-of-Way (ROW) permit.
- The ground breaking ceremony is being planned for later this month.
