Rules and Expectations for John Bapst Memorial High School Dances

1. Students and guests must be admitted to the dance within the first hour. All guests should arrive with the John Bapst student who is responsible for them.
2. Students and guests are expected to leave the building promptly upon the end of the dance.
3. Students and guests must enter and exit through the foyer door. Anyone who leaves before the end of the dance will not be allowed back into the building.
4. Students and guests are only allowed to be in the foyer, auditorium, and first floor hallway (to the boys bathroom on one side and the water fountain across from the main office on the other side). Use of any stairwell going up to the second floor is prohibited, and no one is allowed to go to any other place in the building, including lockers.
5. Proper attire is required. Clothing should allow for freedom of movement without excessive exposure. Chaperones will determine if attire is not appropriate and may ask students to change.
6. Containers, cups, water bottles, food, and similar items may not be brought into the building.
7. Drugs, alcohol, and nicotine products and associated paraphernalia are strictly forbidden. Chaperones will call the parents of any student whom they suspect has used or possesses any of these substances and ask them to come pick up their student. Law enforcement may be contacted, too.
8. Everyone in attendance is expected to dance in an appropriate manner. Dancers must face each other and any dancing that may be considered obscene is prohibited.
9. Chaperones have the right and responsibility to remove students and guests from dances for failure to adhere to the established rules and expectations.
