

Dear Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade Parents/Guardians:

The students have been working very hard and are thrilled to be performing for you this year at the Spring Concert! As **Thursday, April 30th** approaches, I would like to remind the students and inform the parents/guardians of some important information regarding the concert.

WHAT TO WEAR

The theme of this year's show is ***THE BEACH***, so any concepts for outfits can be centered around that idea (for example, beach gear, sunglasses, Hawaiian shirts, tropical prints, leis, sundresses, etc.). I will leave the selection and creativity of your outfits in your hands, but bear in mind the students need to be able to move freely to perform their choreography. If you are unsure about anything, please feel free to e-mail me (see below for contact info).

Please try to **avoid** any of the following items for the performance:

- Sweatpants/Sweatshirts/Hoodies
- Shoes with heels higher than 1 inch (flat shoes are strongly recommended)
- If swim wear is part of your outfit, make sure you are appropriately covered (no exposed midriffs or torsos)
- Any low-dangling jewelry that can get caught easily
- Ripped or torn clothing items
- Clothing with non-school appropriate graphics and/or text
- Large hats or other accessories that may obstruct other performers

Students who do not adhere to the West Ridge school dress code will not be permitted to perform! No exceptions!

DATE, TIME, AND PLACE

The performance will be on **Thursday, April 30th at 9:00am** in the West Ridge School Multipurpose Room. All family and friends are welcome to watch! Entry will be through the blue doors at the front of the building.

Doors will open at 8:45am. Please **do not park your cars in numbered spots**, as they are assigned to staff members. The runtime of the program is approximately 50 minutes.
