Prom Tickets are now on sale online through gradebook/focus.

Juniors and Seniors can purchase one ticket online for \$50 until the week of Prom.

Underclassman tickets must be purchased for \$50 with cash, check or card in the Activities Office, before school or at lunch with a upper classman.

The price for student tickets increases to \$60 on April 6 and must be purchased during lunch with cash, check or card.

All ticket sales stop on Thursday, April 9 at 3:30 Please contact Ms. Lilly with any questions.

Attire for prom is formal dress and pants. Jeans are not acceptable. More detailed information will be in your school email and the Junior Class Steering Committee Instagram. For specific questions, check with Ms. Lilly.

With testing season upon us in approximately 20 days, I'd like to see all students that take End of Course exams perform well. Performing well means earning a passing score of a level 3 or higher. I have added an incentive to host a Field Day on May 27th, for 2 periods in the afternoon on the athletic fields. The criteria is for students to earn a passing score on 1 or more of the following EOC exam(s) that pertain to you: ELA Grade 9 PM 3, ELA Grade 10 PM 3, Algebra 1 EOC, Geometry EOC, and US History EOC.

Students that improve a level from last year's Math EOC or ELA EOC score may qualify to attend the field day event as well. Students who are not earning a passing score or level change from the past school year will not be invited to attend.
