## Checkouts on Prom Day

All students attending prom must be in school attendance up to 4<sup>th</sup> period on the day of prom prior to checkout. The prearranged checkout form or parent in-person checkout is required. Students who are not in school attendance may be denied entry to prom.

With testing season upon us in approximately 20 days, I'd like to see all students that take End of Course exams perform well. Performing well means earning a passing score of a level 3 or higher. I have added an incentive to host a Field Day on May 27<sup>th</sup>, for 2 periods in the afternoon on the athletic fields. The criteria is for students to earn a passing score on 1 or more of the following EOC exam(s) that pertain to you: ELA Grade 9 PM 3, ELA Grade 10 PM 3, Algebra 1 EOC, Geometry EOC, and US History EOC.

Students that improve a level from last year's Math EOC or ELA EOC score may qualify to attend the field day event as well. Students who are not earning a passing score or level change from the past school year will not be invited to attend.
