The Veterans of Foreign Wars is a non-profit veterans organization, with an objective of providing assistance to, and advocating for, our nation's veterans and our community. Our members are men and women who have served in the Armed Forces of the United States during times of conflict.

Private First Class Carl LaRock (1909 - 1994) served in the US Army during World War II. He was a member of the VFW Old Settlers Post 4659 in the Village of Disco, now part of Shelby Township.

When he passed away, Comrade LaRock willed a large portion of his estate to VFW Post 4659 to be used at our discretion. By vote of the membership, those funds were placed in a special scholarship fund titled "The Carl LaRock Scholarship". \$1,000.00 will be awarded to up to three randomly chosen winners each school year. We feel that we could find no more fitting tribute to our departed comrade. Through these scholarship awards, Carl LaRock lives on to assist deserving students in furthering their education.

Requirements of Application for the Carl LaRock Memorial Scholarship

The Scholarship is available to high school seniors of local high schools and accredited homeschoolers in our area. It is also available to all qualifying children and grandchildren of VFW Post 4659 members, regardless of residence, who meet all other criteria.

All applicants must be under the age of 21 by September 1, 2026 and be enrolled in any college, university or trade school for the upcoming school year.

If the applicant is a veteran, add one year of age for each year of military service.

A minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 (on a scale of 4.0) is required. Veterans, children and grandchildren of **any** veteran will benefit from a .25 addition to their G.P.A.

A letter of acceptance from any college, university or trade school must accompany your application.

An official transcript of grades must accompany your application.

All applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than April 17. The drawing will be held at the post meeting on April 22.
