The state of North Carolina requires students in grades 6, 7, and 8 to take End-of-Grade (EOG) assessments in reading and math, Science EOG in grade 8 as well Math 1 EOC. The purpose of these assessments is to monitor student progress and mastery of state standards and objectives. To ensure your child's EOG/EOC performance is a true reflection on his/her learning progress, we would like to inform you of an important opportunity for students who do not score at a proficient level on their initial End-of-Grade (EOG) state assessment(s) or End-of-Course [Math 1] state assessment. In accordance with state guidelines, students who are not proficient on their initial assessment(s) will have the opportunity to retake the assessment during the school year. Participating in the retest will provide students with another chance to show what they know and may positively impact their academic record and placement decisions.

Key Information:

- Retests will be administered on **Tuesday June 2 - Friday June 5** at **Southwest High School**.
- In order for your student to take advantage of this opportunity parents/guardians must provide written consent for their student to take the retest. [see form below]
- Parents will be notified of their students' results via the Infinite Campus student or parent portal.
- Students will receive remediation prior to the retest.
- The highest score will be reflected in the students' academic record.
- The highest scores will be used to calculate the student's overall final grade in reading, math and science [8].

If you would like your child to participate in the EOG/EOC retest opportunity, if needed, please complete and return the form below to your child's teacher or the school office no later than **March 20, 2026**. **You may US mail the letter or email a copy to OVS@onslow.k12.nc.us. The letter must have original signatures and not typed signatures.**
