



FINANCIAL AID, BRIGHT FUTURES & FAFSA SUPPORT

- Review Financial Aid Packages: Log in to your chosen institution's financial aid portal to officially accept or decline your offered grants, scholarships, and loans.
- Submit the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) to be considered for Bright Futures.
 - Ensure all academic eligibility requirements are met, including GPA, test scores, and coursework.
- Submit verified volunteer or work hours and the required reflection to the school counselor.
- Monitor the status of the Bright Futures application through the Florida Department of Education portal.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) if not already submitted.
 - If you still need to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid, join us for a dedicated support session on April 18th.



ACCOUNT COMMUNICATION & MANAGEMENT

- Update college accounts with a personal (non-PCSB) email address, as PCSB email access will end after graduation.
- Regularly check the college portal for updates, deadlines, and required forms.



FINAL HIGH SCHOOL REQUIREMENTS

- Complete the Spring Senior Survey in Xello to indicate the destination for the final high school transcript.
- Ensure all graduation requirements are met before final transcripts are sent.
- Return all school materials, including textbooks, technology, and uniforms.



TRANSFERRING COLLEGE CREDITS

- For AP Exam Credit:
 - Request official AP score reports through the College Board to be sent directly to the designated university.
- For Dual Enrollment Credit:
 - Request an official transcript from Saint Petersburg College (SPC) for any completed dual enrollment courses.
 - Confirm that the receiving institution has processed and applied the credits.
