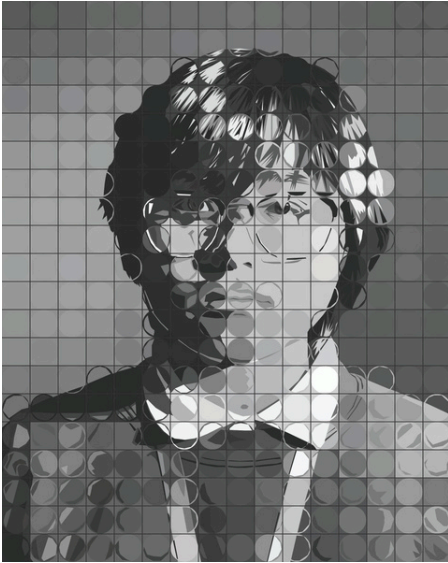

Young Artists' Showcase

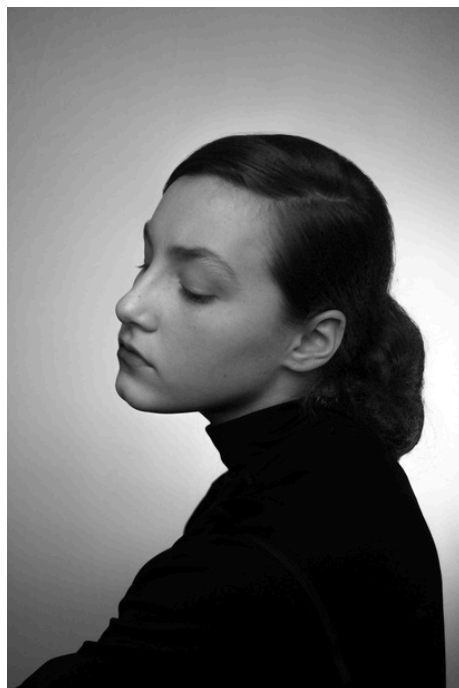
Three students' works were selected by Juror Mel Tychonviech to be included in the Young Artists' Showcase 2026 at The St. Louis Artists' Guild!
