Work Permit Criteria

Work Permit Eligibility and Process: Students must have a job offer, demonstrate and maintain a 2.0 GPA and satisfactory school attendance in order to obtain a work permit application.

The attached work permit application must be turned in to the Main Office to be processed once completed by the student, parent, and employer.

Board Policy 5113.2:

Work Permits: “In determining whether to grant or continue a work permit, the Superintendent or designee shall consider whether employment is likely to significantly interfere with the student's schoolwork. Students granted work permits must demonstrate and maintain a 2.0 grade point average and satisfactory school attendance, except during periods of extended school closure due to an emergency as described in Education Code 49200 and the accompanying administrative regulation. On a case-by-case basis, the Superintendent or designee may approve a maximum work hour limit that is lower than the limit specified in law and administrative regulation. (cf. 5121 - Grades/Evaluation of Student Achievement)”

Revocation/Expiration of Work Permits: “The Superintendent or designee shall revoke a student's work permit whenever the Superintendent or designee determines that employment is impairing the health or education.”
