

Prom Info 2026
Concord-Carlisle High School Prom

Where: Hilton Boston Park Plaza, 50 Park Plaza, Boston, MA 02116

When: Saturday, May 16th, 2026, 7:00 pm – 10:30 pm (doors close at 7:45 pm)

Cost: Prom Ticket: \$152, Coach Bus and Prom Ticket: \$181

Ticket Sales Information:

- *Online:* Tickets can be purchased online by a Junior or Senior, April 7th - April 28th

 - You will need an access code to purchase a ticket online. Please see below for additional information. Codes will be sent on Tuesday, April 7th.

Materials not Returned:

- Students cannot purchase Prom tickets if they have outstanding **missing materials or charges**.

To be eligible to purchase tickets starting April 7th, all materials must be returned **before April 7th at 11:00 AM** to receive your code. If you return materials after that time, you will need to wait until your returns have been processed and your code has been generated (see below regarding codes).

- Students who owe materials or have outstanding obligations will see “**Account Statement Concord**” on the Aspen home screen in the “**published reports**” section.
- Students should return the materials or payment directly to the specified department(s) on the account summary. Parents, please remind your students not to leave a book on anyone’s desk without speaking directly with an assistant.

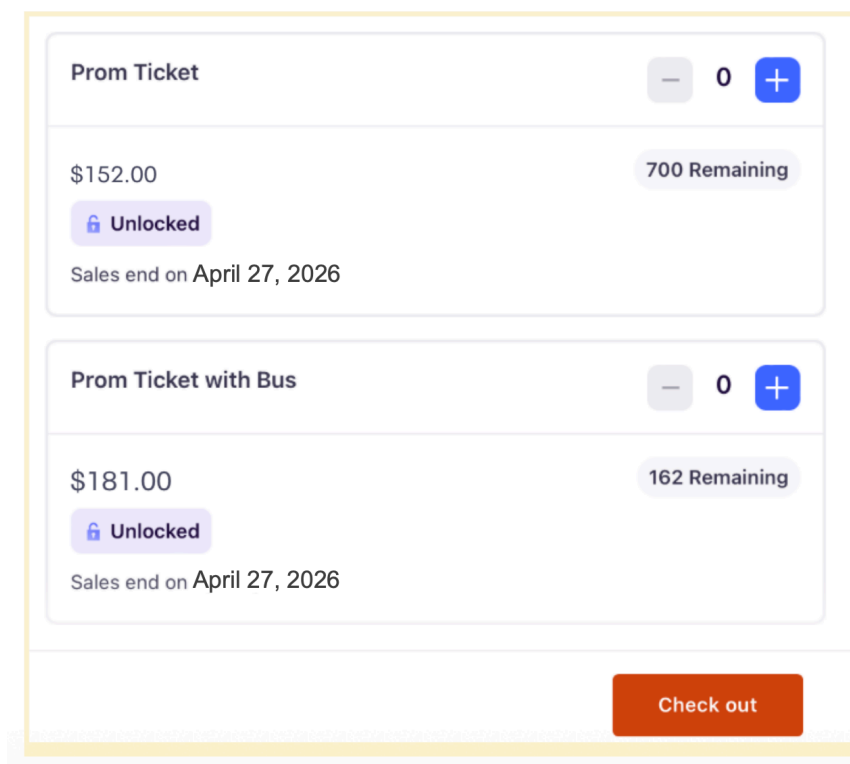
Access Codes:

- Each student purchasing a prom ticket will need a **unique access code**. Each code allows the purchase of one ticket.
- Students with no outstanding materials will receive their access code via their @concordcarlisle email on **Tuesday, April 7th**.
- If you owe materials, you will not receive a code. You must return the missing materials to the appropriate departments. After doing so, students can receive your access code. Once all of your materials have been returned, please see **Ms. Merna in the Main Office** to receive your code.

- To purchase online:
 - click the button



- enter your access code “Promo Code” section in the next window and click “APPLY” to reveal the prom tickets



- If you want to purchase more than one ticket (i.e., a ticket for you and your guest/date), you will need two access codes and complete two different transactions.
- If you are bringing a guest (see section below), you will receive an access code once you return the completed [guest paperwork](#) to **Ms. Merna** in the Main Office

Coach Buses:

- If taking the private coach buses provided by CCHS, please arrive at the front of the school at 5:45 pm. Coach buses will return around 11:15 pm.

Non-CCHS Guests:

- Students who do not attend CCHS are eligible to attend the prom as a guest of a CCHS Junior or Senior.
- There is a [separate guest form](#) that must be completed prior to purchasing tickets.

This form includes the signature of the guest's school Principal/Headmaster, a photocopy of the student ID, and the signature of a CCHS Administrator.

Completed forms must be returned to Ms. Merna to receive an access code. Guests who do not have these forms will not be allowed to attend.

- Forms are also available on the CCHS Student News message.

Photography:

- The ticket cost includes photography.
- Photographers will attend the prom to take formal and candid photographs.
- The photos will be posted there a few days after the prom, by May 22nd at [CCHS Prom 2026 Photo Gallery](#) using password: **cchsprom26**

Other Info:

- Students must attend the **FULL** day of school (**8:00 am – 2:41 pm**) on Friday, May 15th to attend the prom.
- Students must arrive at the prom by **7:45 pm**. No one will be allowed in after 7:45 pm.
- Students may not leave until the completion of prom at 10:30.
- There will be a breathalyzer at the entrance to the prom.
- It is recommended that students do not drive to Boston to attend the prom. It is encouraged that students take the coach bus or use alternative transportation.
