#### POSITION OVERVIEW:

This person will be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Sideline Cheerleading team. Qualified candidates must fully support the [vision & values](#) of Southwest Christian High School (SWCHS) and the Athletics philosophy.

#### POSITION DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Provide a vision for the Cheerleading Program:

- Develop team expectations through the handbook and other communications
- Develop off-season training and conditioning program, including summer camps

Coaching and related administrative duties:

- Participates in practice sessions that are both engaging and instructive, conducted on a regular basis to develop the athlete's greatest potential; teaches fundamental skills of Cheerleading.
- Coaches and instructs students, individually or in groups, regarding the rules, regulations, equipment, and techniques of the sport; follows MSHSL requirements.
- Observes students, during events and practice to determine the need for individual or team improvement; provide necessary feedback.
- Responsible for communication with the students and parents regarding expectations, schedules, etc.
- Works with the Athletic Director in scheduling facilities for practices and competitions.
- Participates in special activities, including parent's night, banquets, and award nights.
- Oversees equipment and systematic return of all equipment at the finish of each session and season.
- Assigns duties to an assistant coach as necessary.
- Attend coaches' meetings as assigned by the Athletic Director.

#### QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

- Previous head coaching or extensive assistant coaching experience at the high school level or higher.
  - Demonstrated ability to assess students's skills, monitor athletes during events and practice.
  - Demonstrates solid organizational skills and ability to effectively communicate verbally and in writing; maintain effective working relationships with school staff,

- Must possess a thorough knowledge of the rules, regulations, strategies, and techniques of Cheerleading.
- Ability to be flexible with personal schedule for practices and games.
