



## Prom Attire & Guest Guidelines 2026

Appropriate gentlemen's attire includes suits or tuxedos. Appropriate ladies' attire includes formal or semi-formal length dresses or pant suits. Dresses or pants may not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh (this is fingertip length, with arms lying flat at sides). The neckline should be modest (no low-cut bodices). 2-piece dresses may not have a bare midriff which exceeds 2 inches. Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the navel. Strapless dresses are permitted. Transparent material is permitted for dresses in the midriff area as long as it adheres to the bare midriff 2-inch rule.

This is a formal event. Any student or guest that the administration considers, as being dressed inappropriately will be required to contact a parent/guardian to bring appropriate clothing or to pick up the student or guest. For the duration of the dance, students will be expected to be in compliance with these standards of dress. **If student or guest has any questions regarding appropriate prom attire, please email Mrs. Hudson [jhudson@spchs.org](mailto:jhudson@spchs.org).** Dress code will be strictly enforced at the door. \*Any student attending the Prom must be at least a junior in high school. Underclassmen are not permitted. Also, guests over the age of 20 are not permitted.
