WHAT IS IT?

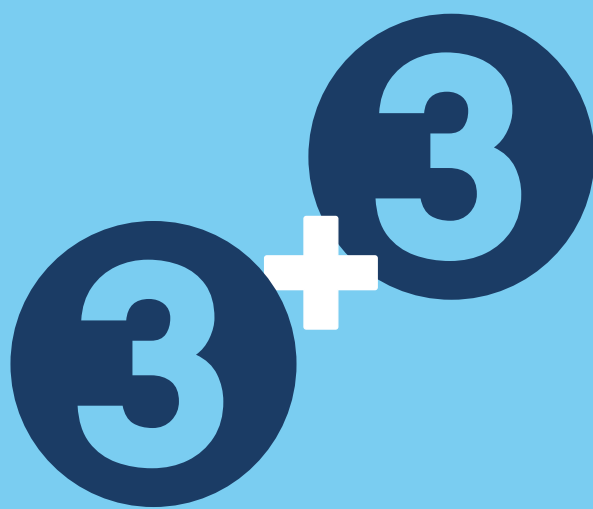
The NYSSB recognizes high school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in English and one or more world languages.

The NYSSB takes the form of a Seal on the student's diploma and a medallion worn at graduation.

HOW DO I EARN THE NYSSB?

There are multiple pathways to earn the NYSSB. Whichever pathway is chosen, students must demonstrate the required level of proficiency by earning 3 points in English and 3 points in one or more world languages from a points matrix.
