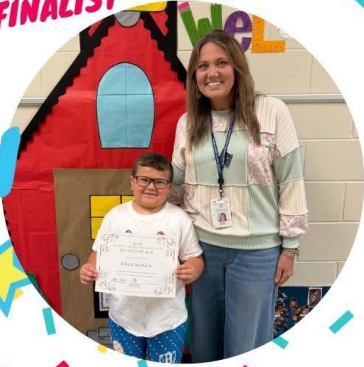

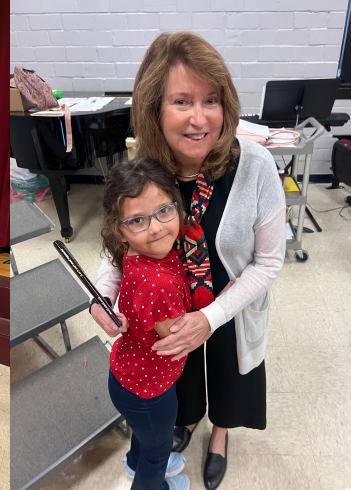


Read Across America Week at PES

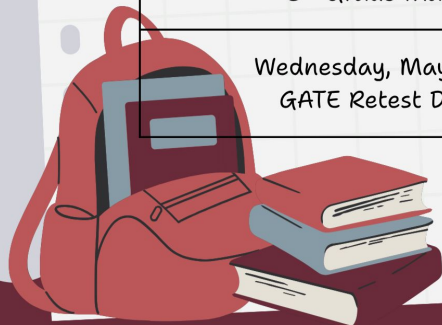


