Eligibility Requirements

1. Child must turn 4 on or before September 1, 2026
2. Child must reside in the Interboro School District
3. Family must meet the 2026 PreK Counts income guidelines for household size described below

1. Use the QR code to request an application for Interboro's 26-27 PreK Counts program.
2. After requesting the application, you will receive a DocuSign to complete within one week of the application request.
3. Once your application is reviewed, you will provide your child's birth certificate, immunization records, proof of residency, and financial documentation.
4. After the documentation is reviewed, you and your child will schedule an on-site screening.
