SUBJECT: **2026-27 Budget Process Workshop**

Business Advisory Services will be conducting workshops to review the procedures for the submission of your district's 2026-27 Adopted Budget. The content of the workshop will focus on providing a review of the procedures required and data assumptions needed to complete the State Adopted Budget forms and is geared to the accounting supervisors and district budget staff responsible for completing these processes. Elements of the workshop will include, but are not limited to:

- ✓ Overview of Budget Process Timelines
- ✓ The Criteria and Standards
- ✓ Overview of Required Forms
- ✓ Estimated Actuals, Beginning and Ending Balance, and Budget Balancing procedures
- ✓ Overview of Procedures for extracting data from Budget Development to SACS Web
- ✓ SACS and State Software changes/updates (if any)
- ✓ Technical Compliance and report submission checklists

The morning will consist of the Budget Process Overview, which is a condensed version of the budget process, with the afternoon consisting of a more specific in-depth workshop that provides detailed instructions on the SACS supplemental forms, Beginning Balances, and Cash Flow Template.

The Budget Process Workshop will be held in person and virtually on Wednesday, May 6, 2026. The workshop will begin at 9:00 a.m. and is scheduled to end at 4:00 p.m. Continental breakfast and lunch will be provided. We will break for 30 minutes for lunch before resuming to present the second half of the workshop.
