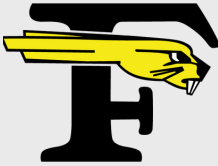
Student Graduates

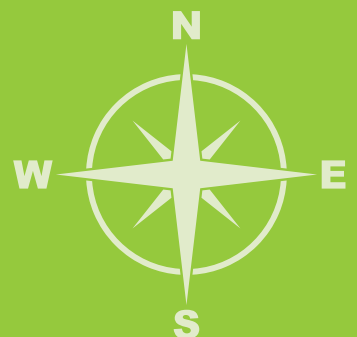
The OC will be cleared at the conclusion of the 1st ceremony, close, and re-open at 4:30 p.m.

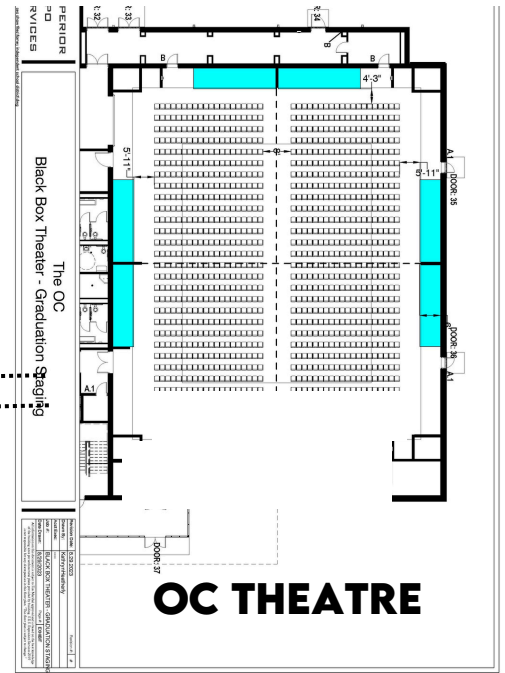
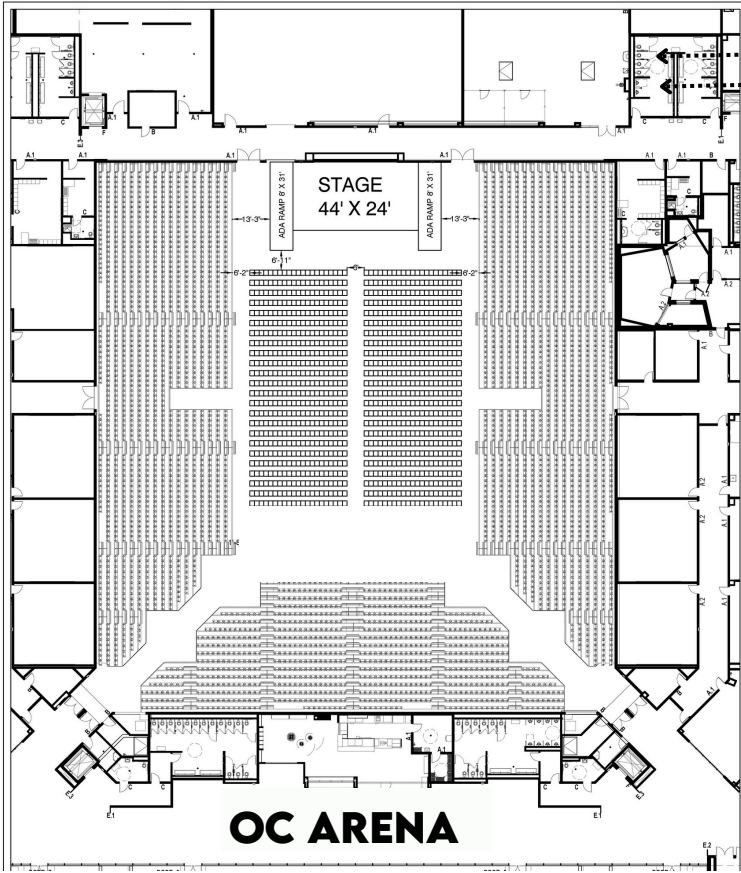
DAY OF GRADUATION PROCEDURES

- Student graduates will arrive at **their high school campus where they will load a bus and be transported to The OC**. *This will ensure campus parking availability and reduce traffic congestion.*
- Before loading the bus at the campus, students should be **ready in cap and gown** and campus admin will check before departing campus.
- Students should **not bring anything on the bus** with them (keys and phone, if necessary, should be placed in pockets). Students will not be able to leave/store items in the OC theatre during graduation.
- Bottled water will be available for graduates at The OC in the theatre.
- At the conclusion of the ceremony, graduates will be dismissed on both east and west sides of the parking lot. Families should plan to meet their graduates at their vehicles. Cell phone reception may not be that strong, so we recommend that you designate a family meeting area ahead of time. Free Wi-Fi is available.

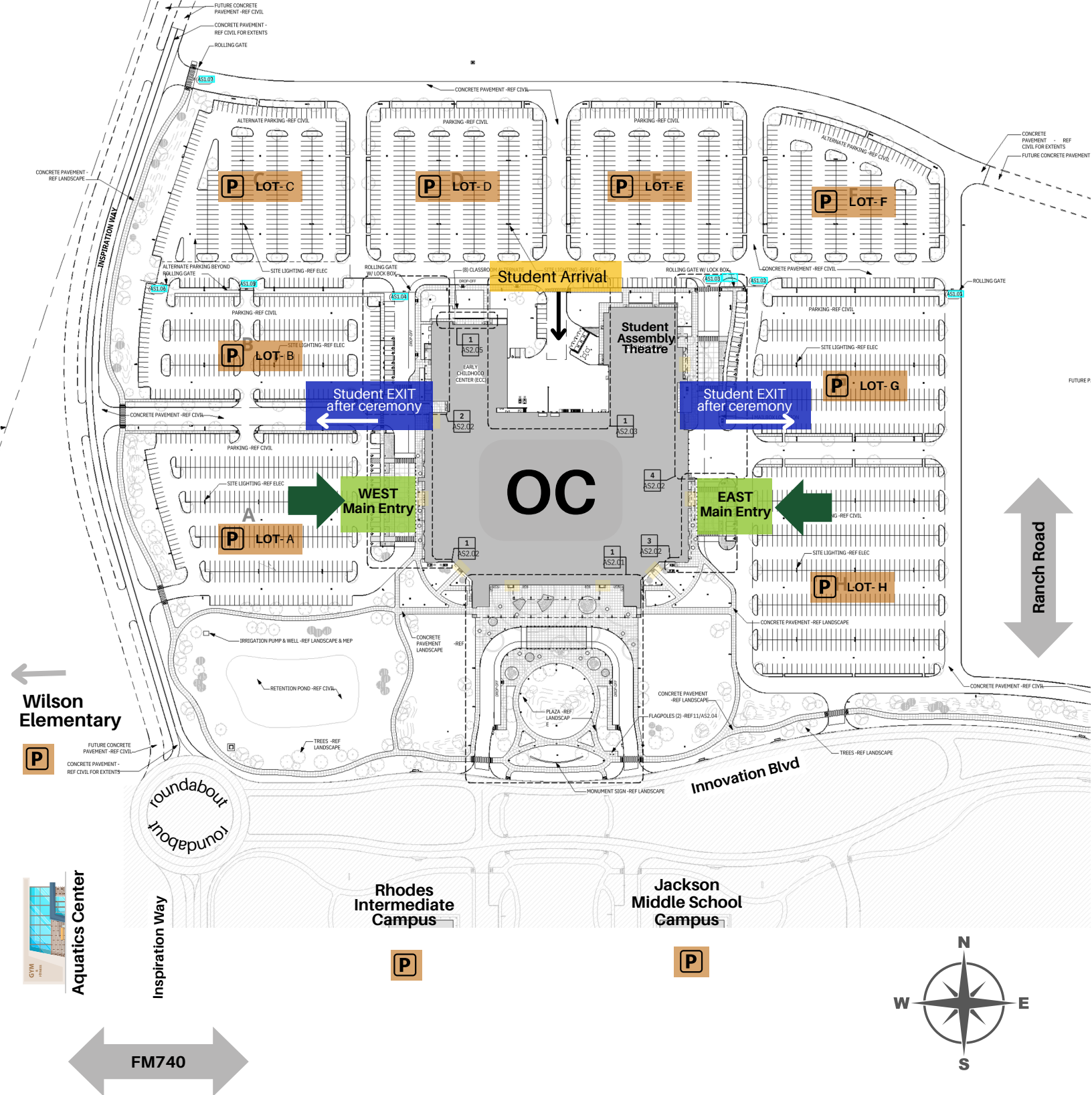
The OC **East** and **West** entrances look very similar. Be sure to remember your parking section and which side you enter so you can find your way.






OC ARENA


The graduation ceremony will take place in the **OC arena**. Student graduates will assemble in the **OC Theatre** and will be lined up for the processional. At the conclusion of the ceremony, students will be dismissed after the recessional and directed outside to the parking lots on both east and west sides.

TRAFFIC FLOW

Guests may enter The OC parking lots from either the east or west.

West parking lots are accessible by Inspiration Boulevard via Ridgecrest Rd/Hwy 740.

East parking lots are accessible by Innovation Boulevard via Ranch Rd.

Innovation and Inspiration Blvds. will both be available as exits from The OC.



GUEST & TICKET INFORMATION

All guests **must have** a ticket to enter The OC. Seating is first-come, first-served general admission. If your family needs ADA accommodations, inside The OC there are ADA ushers stationed at the east and west sides near the elevators. ADA guests may be accompanied by ONE companion and will be escorted to one of the designated ADA seating areas.

Ticket distribution to graduating seniors will be determined and communicated by each campus administration. We do not distribute graduation tickets to anyone other than the graduating seniors. Graduating seniors can distribute their tickets to family and friends.



PHOTOS

Cady Photography photographs every graduate at the ceremony. All graduates will receive an email prior to graduation with information on how to access and purchase photos. An additional email is sent after the ceremony as well.

DISMISSAL

Campus employees will dismiss the graduates at the end of the ceremony. While graduates are being dismissed, families and guests should exit the venue and go directly to their vehicles. Families and graduates should make plans to meet at another location after the ceremony.

THE OC: WEAPONS DETECTION

All guests, visitors, students and staff will be scanned through the weapons detection system upon entry to The OC. All carried items and entrants are subject to search. Prohibited items must be returned to the owner's car or discarded. Any unlawful items are subject to confiscation, and the person in possession of such item is subject to arrest. Items left at the door will be discarded.

THE OC: PROHIBITED ITEMS

- No purses or backpacks (see clear bag policy below)
- No video cameras or cameras with lenses greater than 6"
- No flags, posters or banners
- No outside food or beverages
- No noisemakers
- No strollers or wagons
- No balloons
- No weapons
- No animals (excluding certified service animals)
- No smoking/vaping
- No wrapped gifts

THE OC: CLEAR BAG POLICY

Guests are encouraged NOT to bring bags into The OC for graduation. If necessary, the following are permissible:

- Clear tote - plastic, vinyl or PVC bags that do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12".
- Plastic storage bag - Clear one (1) gallon, re-sealable.
- Small clutch size - approximately the size of a hand with or without a handle or strap. No larger than 6.5" by 4.5".
- An exception will be made for diaper bags and medically necessary items after proper inspection.
