I know it's hard to believe but we are already preparing for our end of the year 8th grade celebration! That being said, every year we run a slide show of our students and ask for parents' help.

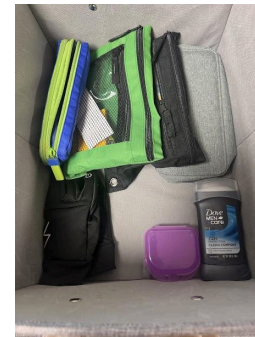
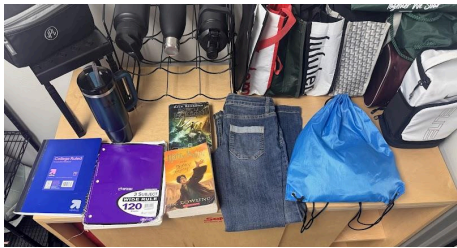
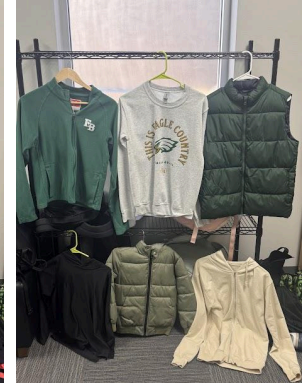
