Senior Check-out

Check-out will be on Friday, June 5th in the library from 1:30pm-3:00pm. Seniors should arrive with enough time to check in materials and pick up caps and gowns and be at the small gym for graduation practice. All seniors must check out in order to receive their diploma.

Cap and Gown Distribution

Herff Jones will be at Rosemont on Friday, June 5th to distribute caps/gowns. If students have not already purchased their caps/gowns, they must bring cash on the day of check-out to purchase directly from Herff Jones.

Graduation Practice

In order to have a flawless and exciting event, graduation practice is MANDATORY. Students must attend all practices, and cannot arrive late or leave early; **students who do not attend the full practice sessions will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.**

- For Practice #1 (Thursday 6/4), students need to meet in the small gym by 9:00am
- For Practice #2 (Friday 6/5), students need to meet in the small gym by 3:00pm.
- Cell phones must be away, and school policies must be followed. If students do not adhere to school policies, they will be dismissed and will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- There is no place to store purses, backpacks, or other personal items; Rosemont High School is not responsible for any lost or stolen items during practices.
- Students who have not earned all of their credits or passed Senior Project are not eligible to participate.
- Students who have exceeded the allowed number of absences/tardies are not eligible to participate.

Graduate Attire

Graduation is a formal, celebratory event and graduates should dress accordingly under their graduation robes, which need to remain zipped up for the duration of the ceremony. Please remember that heels may be difficult/uncomfortable to walk in, as students have a long path to travel for the processional.

Caps: Seniors may decorate their caps for the ceremony. For decorations, seniors **must adhere to all school rules**, which includes no profanity, no depictions of illegal activities, no offensive words or images, etc. Students who have anything inappropriate on their cap will be provided with a loaner cap to cross the stage.

Graduation Ceremony Tickets ten

Tickets: All graduates will receive ten tickets, which will be distributed at Senior Check-out. Children 2 years and older will need a ticket to enter. Children under 2 years old will need to sit on an adult's lap through the duration of the ceremony.

Ceremony Details

The ceremony will last until approximately 7:30-8:00pm and will include speeches from Mr. Jones and SCUSD dignitaries, as well as from selected students.

Open Speech Auditions: If you are interested in giving a speech at graduation, auditions will take place in E206 at lunch on Friday, May 8th. Students must have a 1-2 minute speech prepared and must be willing to meet 2-3 times a week at lunch to practice if their speech is selected; valedictorians and salutatorians will also be required to practice regularly.

Honor Cords/Sashes/Pins/Medallions

Some graduates will have honor sashes/stoles/cords/pins based on special academic accomplishments. All sashes, pins, cords, and medallions must be approved by Mr. Jones or another administrator.

Seating/Balloons/Gifts

Approximately 3000 people will be in attendance at graduation and must comply with rules and regulations set forth by the Golden 1 Center. Doors open at 5:00pm. Families are not allowed to bring in balloons and signs as those tend to interfere with other guests' experience and sight lines of the stage. Blow horns and other noise making devices are also not permitted inside Golden 1 Center.

Showing Support of Graduates

Applause is certainly encouraged for every graduate; however, please make sure that the support does not interfere with the experience of other graduates or their family members. Please be sure to end applause before the name of the next graduate is called.

Diplomas

As graduates cross the stage, they will receive a diploma cover. **Official diplomas will be handed out after the ceremony.**

Prohibited Items

Special Event Parking Resources

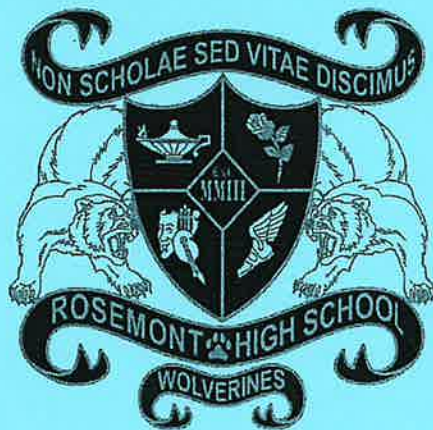
Event parking is now easy! Planning your parking will reduce time spent looking for a spot and save you money. Garages and parking lots activate special event flat rates when an event is expected to cause an increase in volume in the garage. Special event rates may vary according to the size of the event and its proximity from the event. Special event flat rates activate up to two (2) hours prior to an event start time.

SacPark reservations (<https://reserve.sacpark.org/>) are accepted during special event pre-lay mode at select Certified Partner facilities. Some Certified Partners also offer discounts for reserving online or via mobile app. Please check the SacPark reservation system to see when parking reservations are available.
