Award & Description	<p>This award is presented to a graduating senior who has demonstrated a strong commitment to community service through participation in blood drives and/or advocacy for blood donation. In partnership with the New York Blood Center, this scholarship recognizes a student who understands the importance of giving back and helping to save lives.</p> <p>A student must demonstrate leadership and volunteerism in the organization of the high school blood drive. Scholarships in the amount of \$500 – \$2000 are available, depending on the total number of blood drives per academic year and the total donations.</p>
