

Beryl H. Moul Memorial Grange Scholarship

Established in 1958 by West Sand Lake Grange #949 in memory of prominent Grange Member, Beryl H. Moul.

The award value is based on 5% of the market value of the trust, award will vary.

Requirements and Conditions:

Applicants will be considered on the basis of and, in order of importance: (1) scholastic achievement; (2) course of study; (3) community service through involvement in organizations such as church, synagogue, 4-H, Grange, or through school clubs/projects; and (4) financial need.

1. The applicant must be a resident of Rensselaer County for at least 4 years.
2. The applicant must be accepted in an accredited New York 2- or 4-year college program pursuant to a career in one of the following:
 - Agriculture
 - Home Economics (Human Ecology)
 - Forestry
 - Veterinary Medicine
 - Education

Preference will be given to Agriculture, Home Economics (Human Ecology), Forestry, or Veterinary Medicine. Second preference will be given to those in Education.

Procedure:

1. Complete the attached application and include an official 4-year High School transcript.
2. Write an essay of not less than 200 words, detailing your participation in community service and your long range plans and goals.
3. Return the signed application, essay, a reference letter (see application), and transcript by **May 1st to:**
