Multi-Age Groups Information Nights - 2026

In the spring of each year, the adult teachers of the Multi-Age Group (MAG) hold a pair of information nights for the benefit of the B.R.S. community. These information nights offer an opportunity to learn about the MAG option and assist parents in making an informed decision for their family.

The first meeting is a presentation hosted by the entire MAG teaching team explaining the program's history, philosophy, and pedagogy. The presentation also includes a description of a typical day, an overview of the four year-long umbrella projects, and an explanation of the varied groupings. Following this meeting, prospective parents may visit the program during the school day during designated times.

The second meeting is a question and answer session which takes place after visitations - approximately a week after the initial session. This allows parents adequate time to privately discuss the content shared at the first presentation and to prepare any questions they may have. Some current MAG parents will be in attendance to share perspectives.
