GENERAL SPRING 2026 KEYSTONE EXAM TESTING INFORMATION

The Algebra I, Biology, and Literature Keystone Exams will be administered from May 11 - May 21, 2026. All exams this Spring across the entire state will be administered online through Pennsylvania’s secure testing platform. Only students scheduled for a Keystone Exam will be taking an exam during the scheduled time. Please refer to the personalized letter that was mailed to all families to determine if your student needs to report for testing. Scheduled students can fall into 3 different categories requiring them to take Keystone Exams:

- Students who are completing a trigger course, and are testing for the first time
- Students who did not participate in the Keystone Exam previously, but took a trigger course
- Students who did not pass a Keystone Exam that was taken previously and need to retest

The Keystone Exam schedule is below:

Keystone Exam Schedule (all test sessions run from 7:30am - 10:03am in the upper JCM wing)	
Monday, May 11, 2026	Algebra Keystone - Mod 1
Tuesday, May 12, 2026	Algebra Keystone - Mod 2
Wednesday, May 13, 2026	Literature Keystone - Mod 1
Thursday, May 14, 2026	Literature Keystone - Mod 2
Monday, May 18, 2026	Biology Keystone - Mod 1
Tuesday, May 19, 2026	Biology Keystone - Mod 2

3 days will be used as makeup days; only scheduled students should attend

Important Keystone Exam Environment Reminders:

- All students must come to the building to take Keystones; there is no remote option.
- All students will remain in testing classrooms for the entire time of the scheduled session, even if they individually finished testing.
- All students must turn off any personal electronic device and turn it into the test proctor.
- All students must bring their fully charged Chromebook to use.
- All students must show up on time; late arrivals may jeopardize the ability to test that day.

All other students will report to school and will continue with instruction as a regular school day. School buses will run at their regular times in the morning and afternoon.

The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) requires all high school students to complete end-of-course Keystone Exams in Algebra 1, Biology, and Literature. It is important that all students do their best on the Keystone Exam because testing proficiency is the easiest way for students to meet the Graduation Pathway requirement by the end of their junior year. Cyber Academy (PVBA) Students: Report to Pleasant Valley High School for testing on the days indicated. Please contact the Student Services office (570-402-1000 x4007), and we can arrange to provide meals & bus transportation if needed.

MCTI (Vo-Tech) Students: Report to Pleasant Valley High School for testing on the days indicated. Any Co-op students must inform their employers of the *requirement* to attend school during the appropriate time on the indicated days.

Dual Enrollment Students: Report to Pleasant Valley High School for testing on the days indicated. You are responsible to notify your instructor of the reason you will miss that class.
