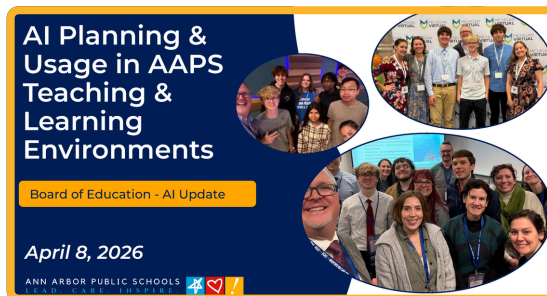
Environmental Education Update

The Ann Arbor Public Schools (AAPS) is required by law to approve its budget for the upcoming school year by June 30. The budget is developed in April and May and presented in public at two regular Board meetings in June. Public hearings are held at both meetings, and notice of these hearings is published on MLive (Ann Arbor News and online) at least seven days before the first hearing.
