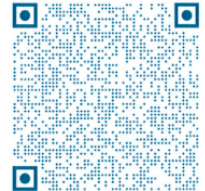
VOCAL: 30 seconds to a minute of a song of your choice.

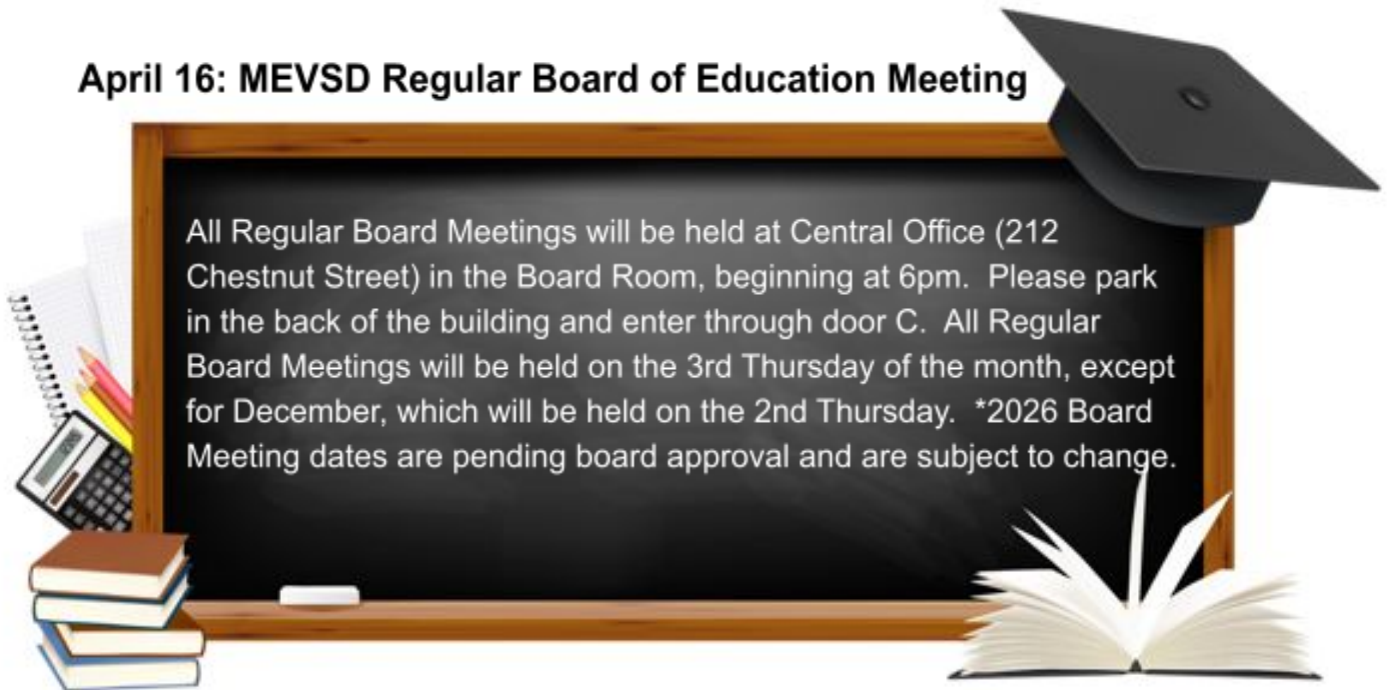
As always, you may view your child's progress on the critical standards in PowerSchool *at any time* by following the directions in the parent guide linked below.

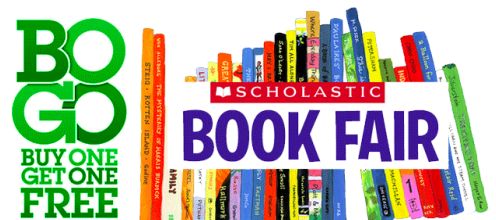

Nurse Notes... Attention 6th Grade Parents: As the school year is starting to wind down, we thought it would be a great opportunity to remind parents of current 6th graders that their child is due for required immunizations prior to entering 7th grade.



As required by The Ohio Department of Health, all students entering 7th grade are **REQUIRED** to have the Tdap vaccine and one dose of the Meningococcal vaccine. Please plan on getting these vaccinations before the start of the 2026-27 school year. You will need to obtain a copy of the most current immunization record (to include Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines) and turn it in to your child's school. Please contact your health care provider or the nurse at school with any questions.

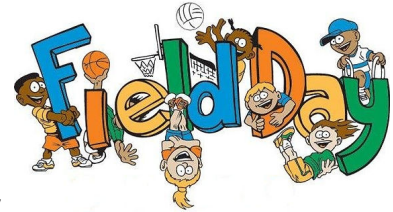
*Reminder- Girls and Coaches currently participating in Girls on the Run programming at their team site are already registered for the 5K and do NOT need to register at the link.
