We are excited to share that the Wyoming High School Science Olympiad Team (grades 9-12) has earned a bid to the State Tournament, to be held April 18th at The Ohio State University.

The Regional event was held on March 7, 2026 at Xavier University. Wyoming High School team A placed fourth overall, and between Team A and B the team medaled in 16 science events. The Science Olympiad team competes in 23 different science events.
