## OLD SPEECH ROOM GALLERY

### FIFTY YEARS ON: THE EVOLVING COLLECTION 1976–2026

**Thursday 23 April–Friday 29 June**

The Old Speech Room Gallery celebrates its 50th anniversary in 2026. All the objects and artworks featured in this special exhibition have been acquired since the gallery's inception in 1976. From the very first donation by artist Victor Pasmore (*Bradlys 1923*) to exceptional photographs by three of the School's royal photographers, as well as rare maps and books, stamps, sculptures, ceramics, medals, prints and portraits acquired more recently, the collection reveals the richness of the gallery's teaching and learning resources. Essential viewing includes an important portrait of Henry Purcell bequeathed in 2023 by former English beak Jeremy Lemmon (*The Grove 1949*), a group of objects relating to the transatlantic slave trade, and a show-stopping addition to the Byron collection gifted by an OH family in 2024.

The recently published *The Old Speech Room Gallery: A Collection Revealed* provides an engaging introduction to the collection and acts as an invaluable supplement to the exhibition.

The OSRG is generally open to the public between 2.30pm and 5pm on Thursdays and Fridays in term time. It will also be open on Saturday 23 May and Saturday 13 June.

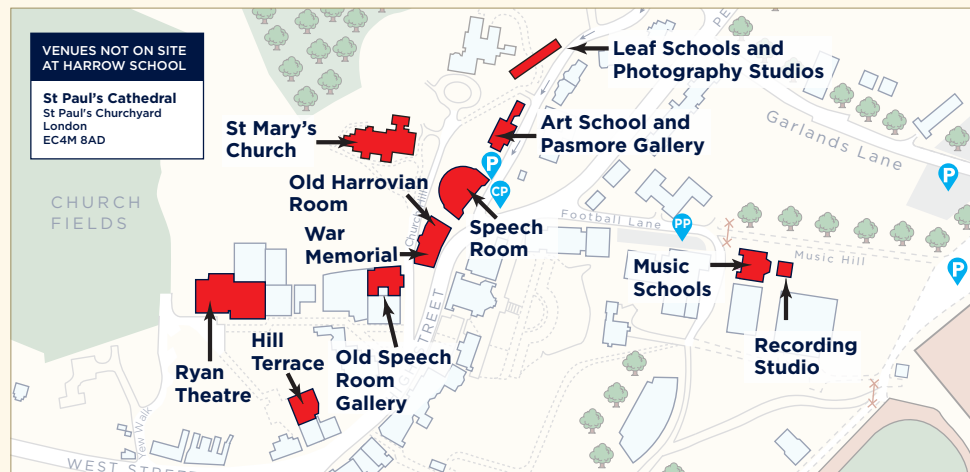
