## Upcoming April School Vacation



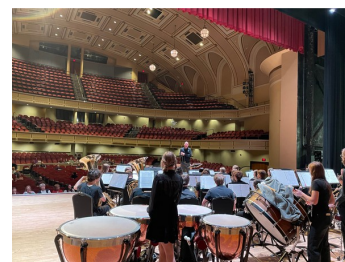
The school will be closed for the April vacation starting Friday, April 17th and concluding on Sunday, April 26th. All students and staff are expected to return to school on Monday, April 27th.

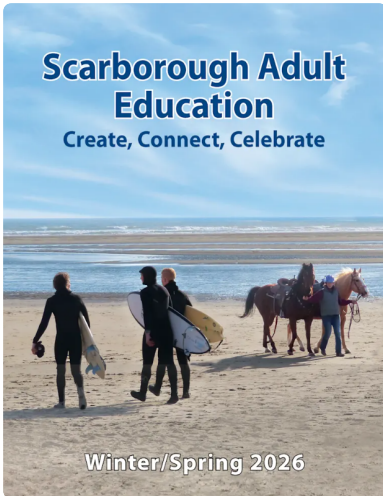
