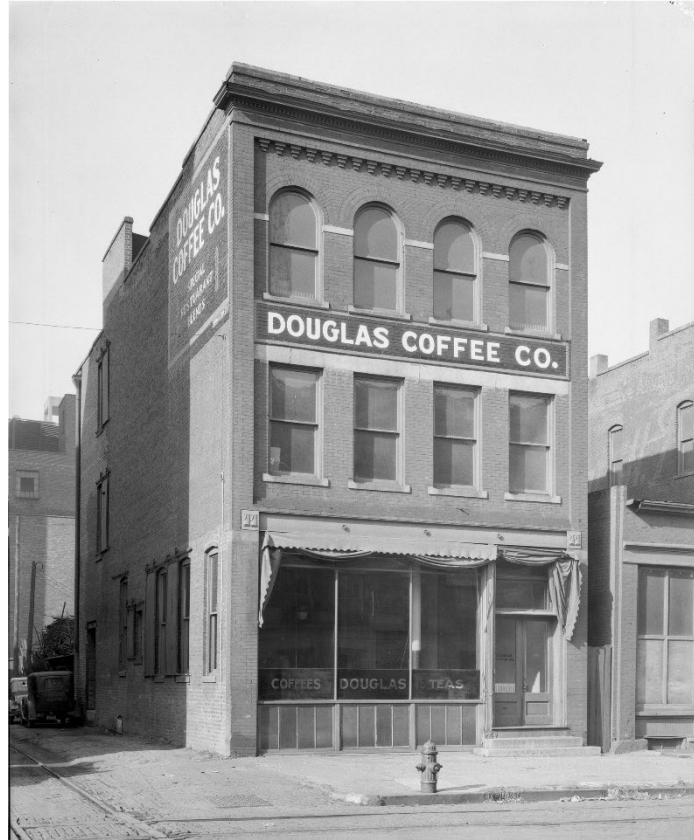

Welcome to the Douglas-Omaha public interactive map viewer - DOGIS! This site includes commonly-requested GIS/map layers maintained by various Douglas County and City of Omaha departments.

#### Here are some things to try:

- Use the search bar, in the top right corner, to find addresses, subdivisions, parks, etc.
  - For example, search by:
    - Parcel ID (PIN) - '0313640000'
    - Address - '1819 Farnam St'
    - Intersection - '72 St and Dodge St'
    - Park name - 'Adams Park'
    - Subdivision name - 'Field Club'
    - SID name or number - 'Timber Shores' or '547'
- Click on map features to view their attributes, related records, and attachments
- Use the identify tool to capture a variety of data within a specified area
- Change visible layers/view legend
- Generate mailing labels
- Print maps

- For Omaha maps start in 1880's and go through 1962.



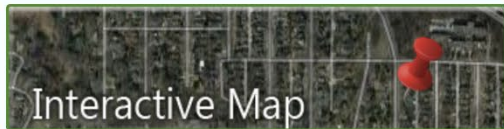

Steel concrete foundation, press and common brick, Lake Superior brownstone, composition roof, copper cornice, plate glass, patent plaster, steam heat, tile flooring, mahogany interior finish, cementing, decorating, fireproofing, gas fixtures, hollow tile, iron beams, shutters and columns, mosaic work, marble, metal lath, skylights, tiling and five vaults. Cost, \$50,000. Plans will be ready for figures June 20th.

Frank B. Kennard will erect a modern 3-story apartment house at 19th and Dodge sts., on plans by Fisher & Lawrie, architects. It will be 80x120, of pressed brick, containing 18 apartments of 4 and 6 rooms. A hot water heating plant will be installed. Cost about \$50,000.

The First Church of Christ, Scientist, has adopted plans by F. W. Clarke, architect, for a new church, and expects to start the work without delay. It will be of pressed brick with stone and terra cotta trimmings. Cost, \$50,000 to \$60,000.
