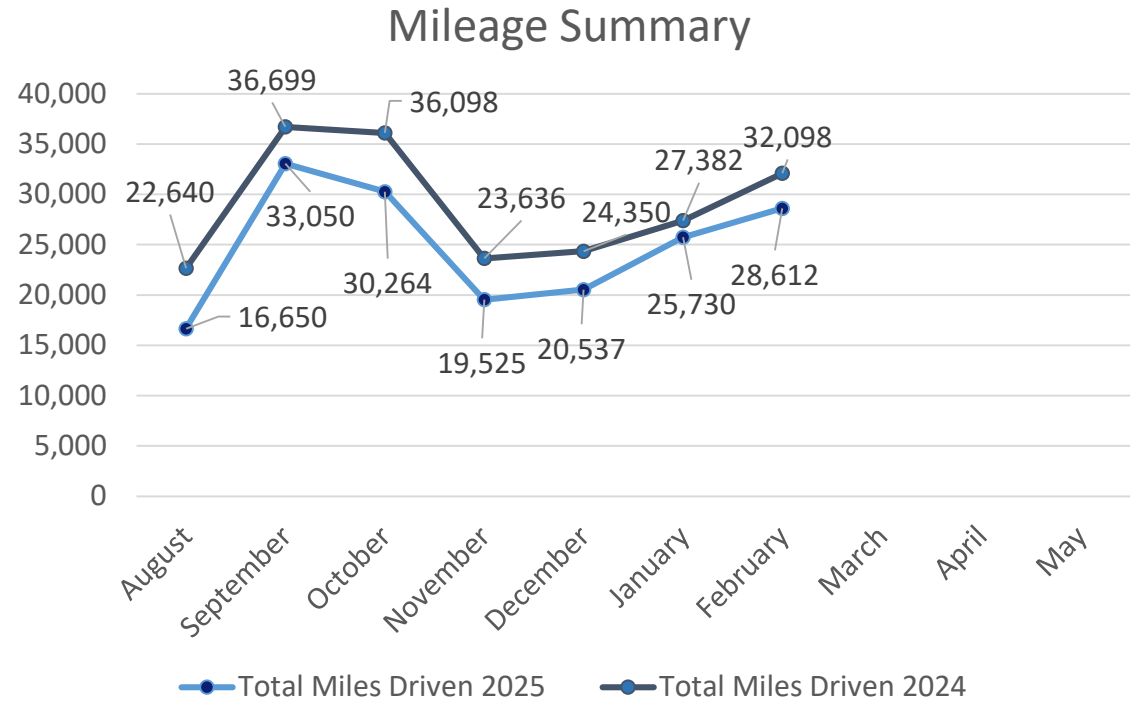


# March Transportation Department Update

## Key Transportation Highlights for February:

### School Bus Operations

- Regular Bus Routes **22,693** Miles Driven
  - **16% Less** Route Miles than Feb. 2025 due to routing efficiencies
  - **18.5%** of Route Miles dedicated to **SpEd Route** (a 23% increase from February '25)
- **23 Sports/Activity Trips** – **1,978** Miles
  - **8.8%** of total driven miles year-to-date
- **PR2TA Shuttle** – **1,413** Miles
  - **8,175** Student Transports
  - EHS/True North to PR2TA & Return
- Total Miles Driven: **28,612** ↓ **11%** from February 2025

## **Focus Areas For February That Were Planned:**

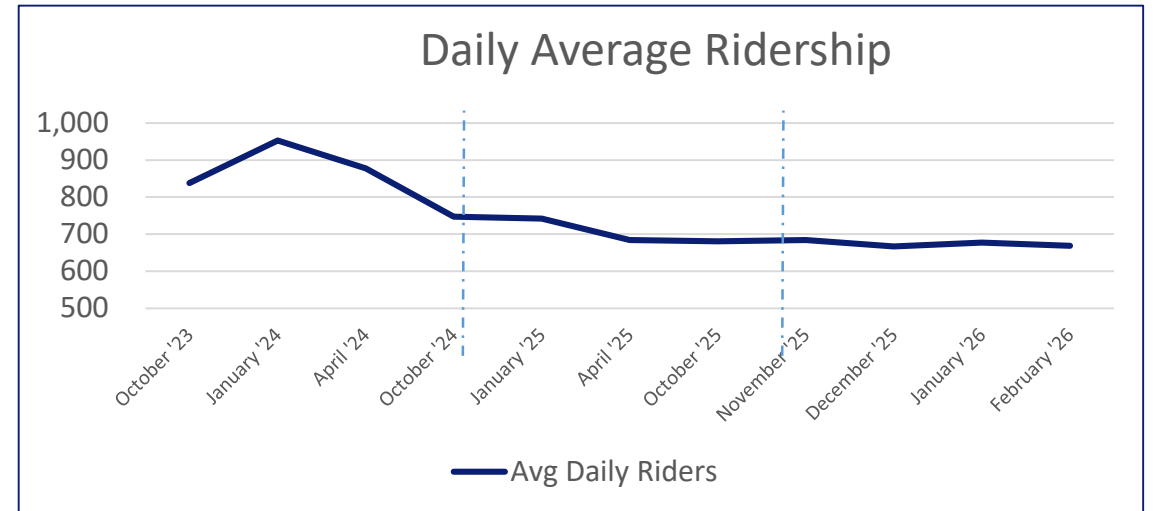
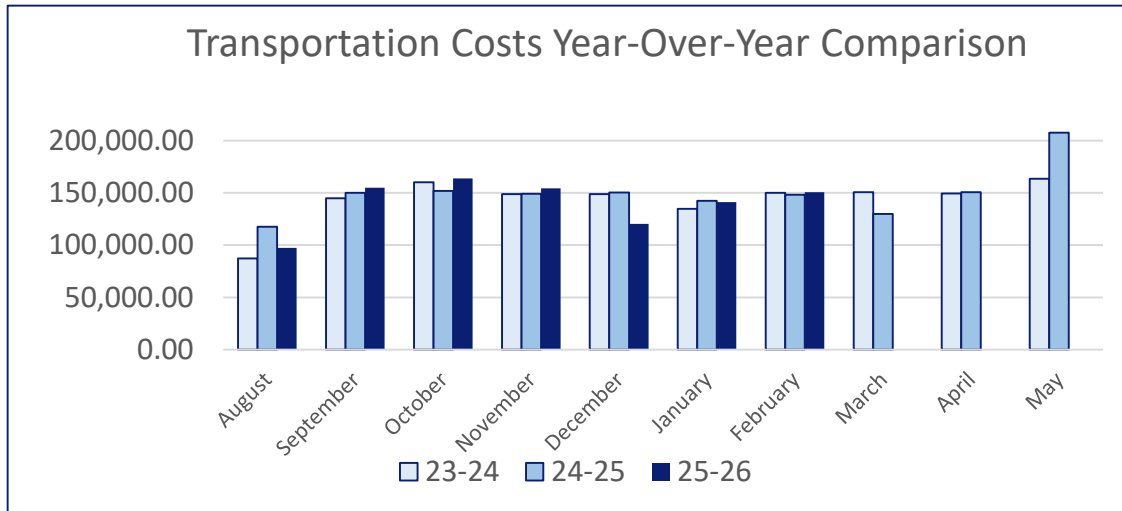
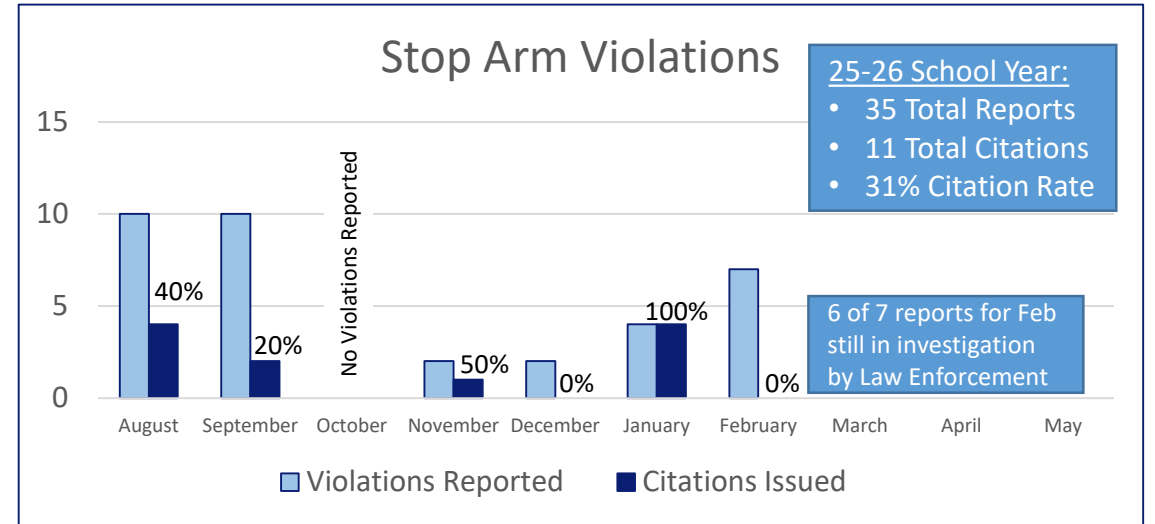
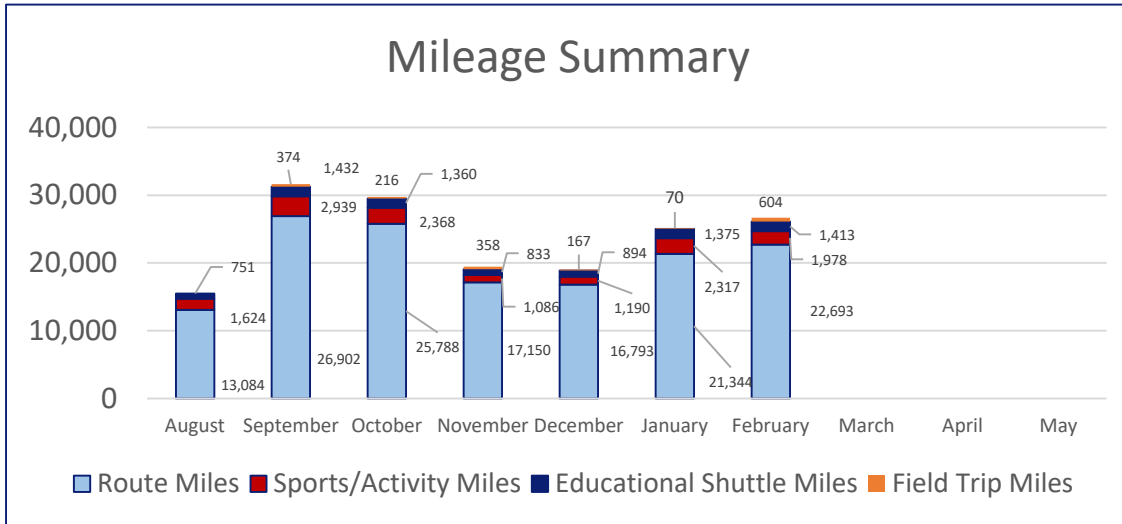
- Analyze Ridership Data for Deeper Insights

## **Focus Areas for March:**

- Review Student Safety First Plans with District Leadership
- Gather peer-to-peer feedback on driver & aid overall performance for annual review cycle
- Complete all Bus Driver Ride-a-Long Driving Evaluations for 25-26 School Year
- Complete 2 hours towards 10 State Mandated Annual Training Hours for Drivers/Aids (8.5 of 10 to be completed)
