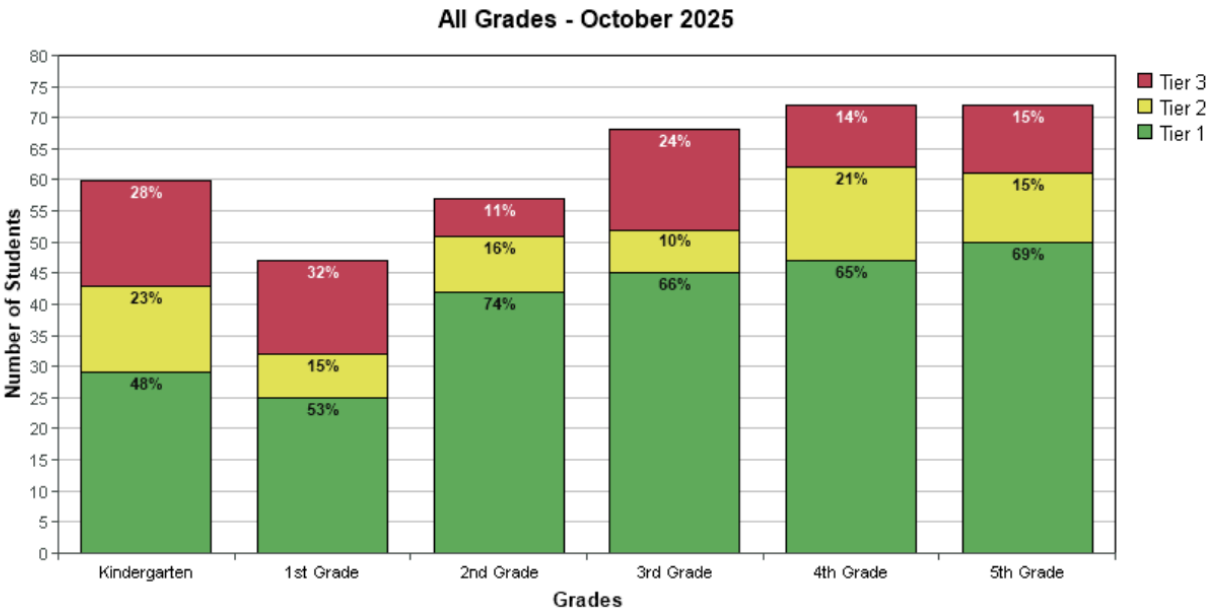

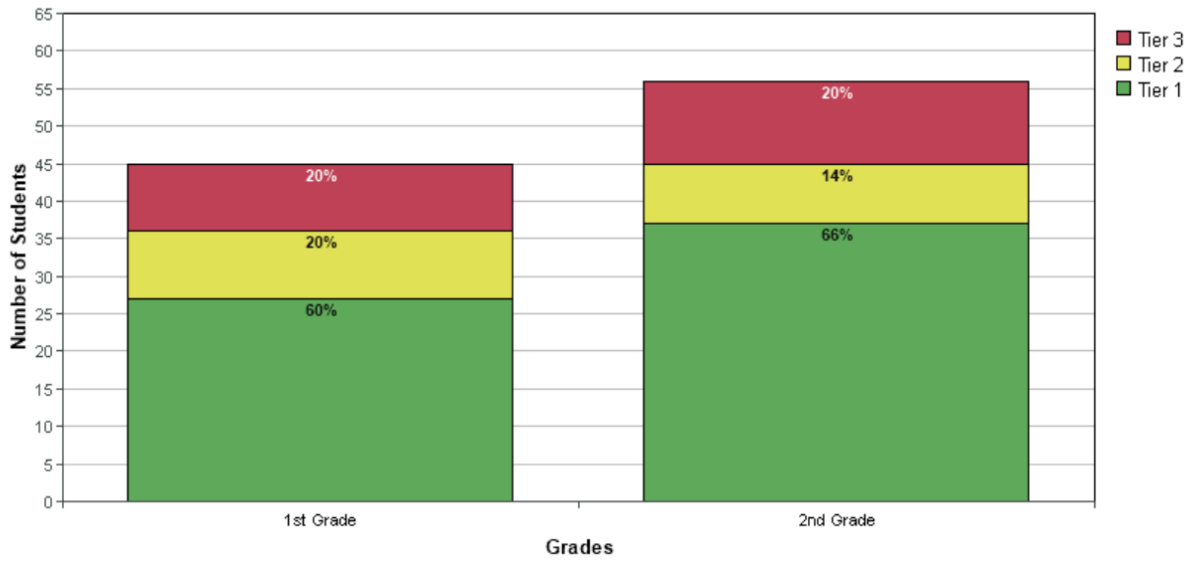

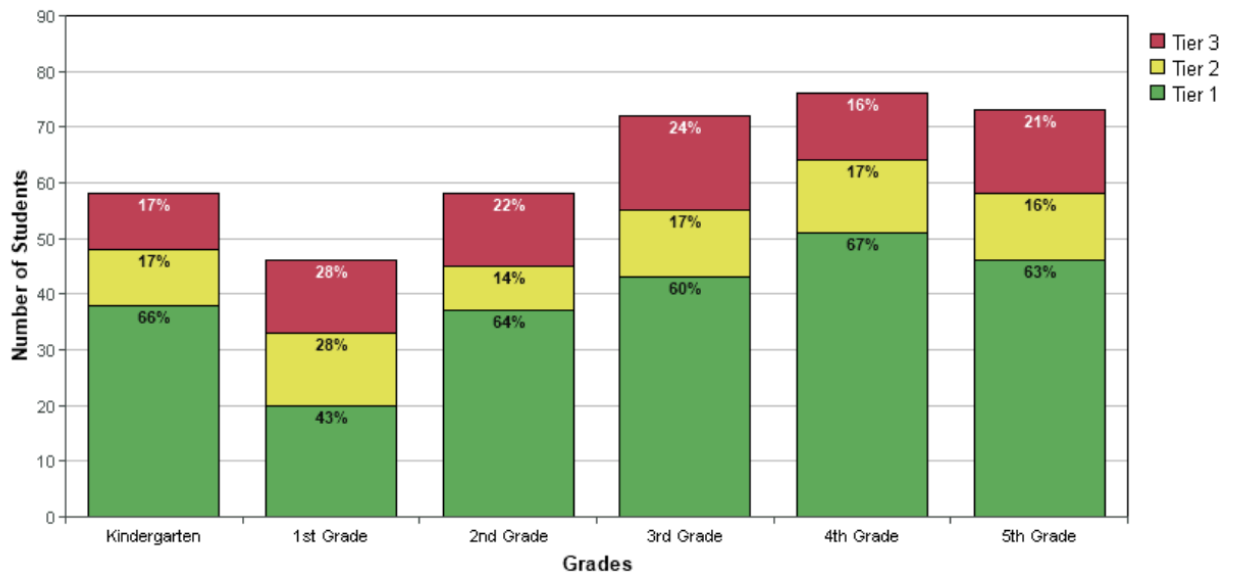
★ **ISIP Reading Scores** - 4th and 5th are using IXL to Benchmark students for the fall and will use their diagnostic scores to watch progress.



All Grades - December 2025



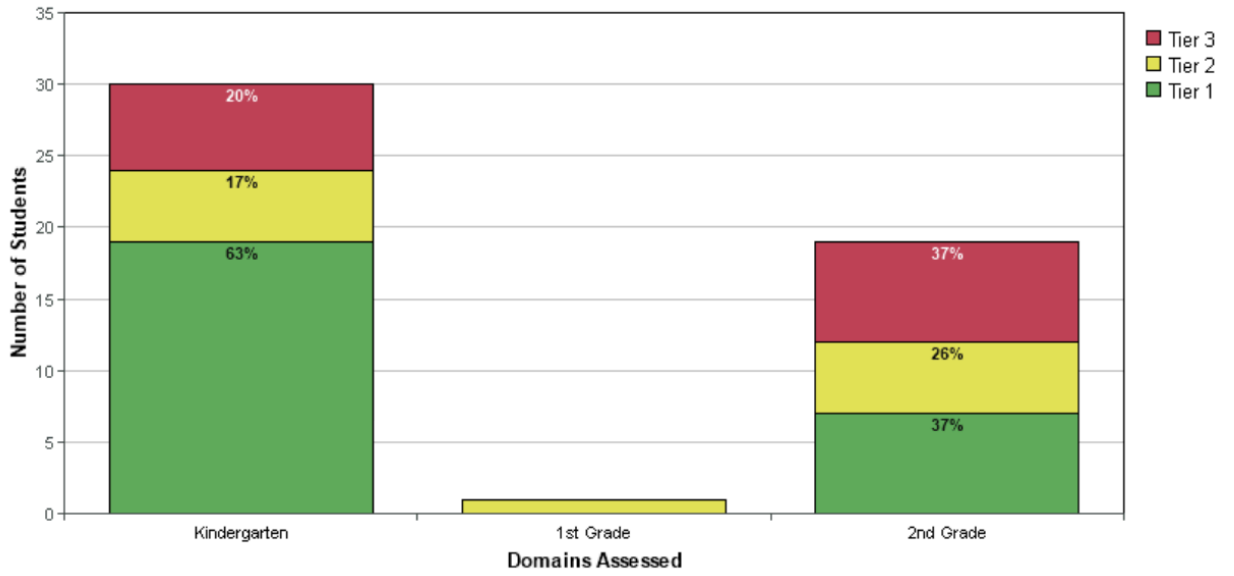
All Grades - February 2026



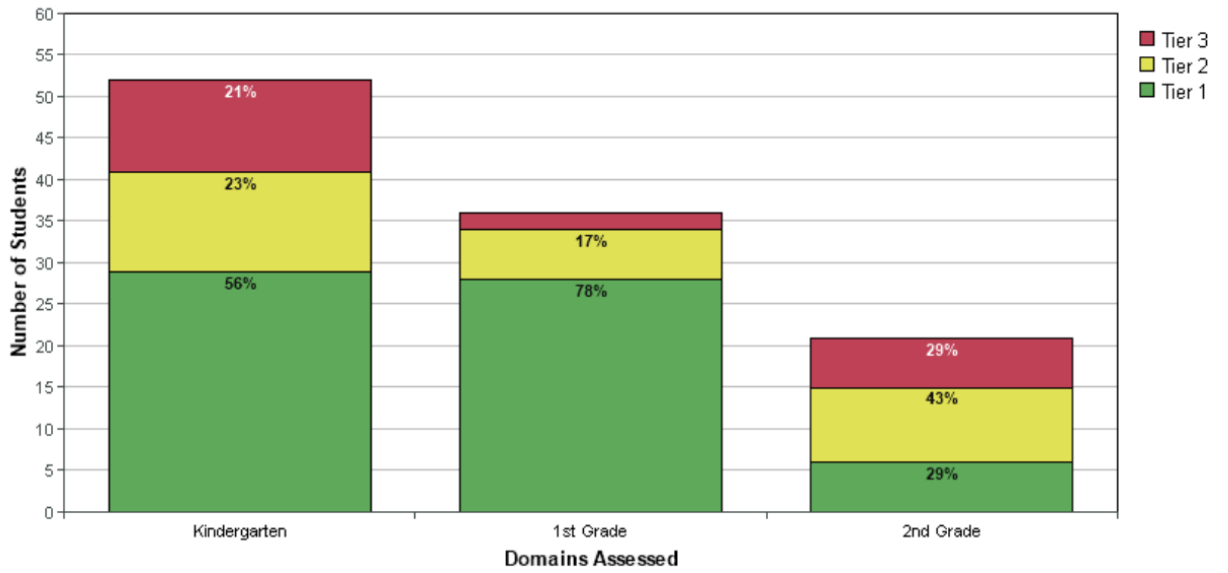

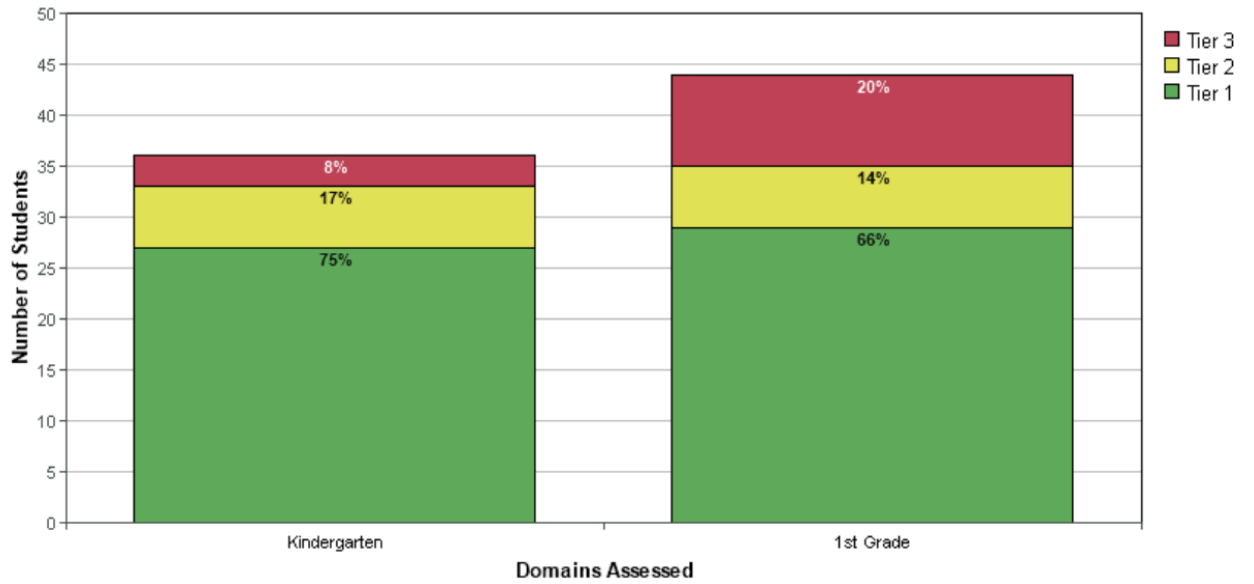
**All Grades - October 2025**

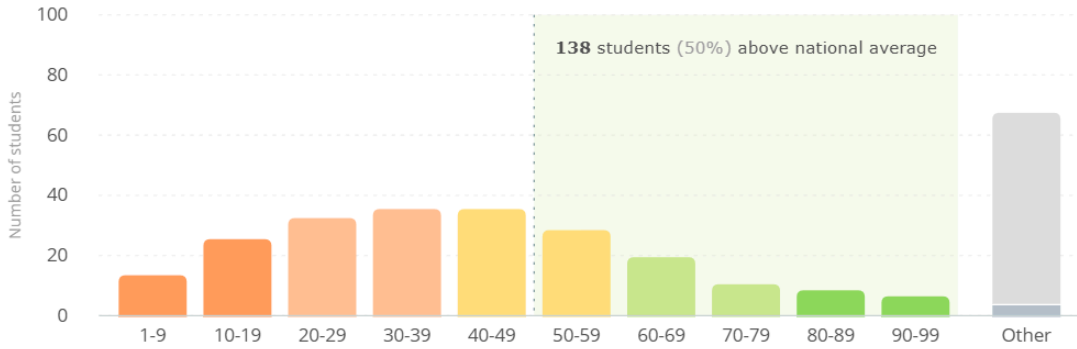

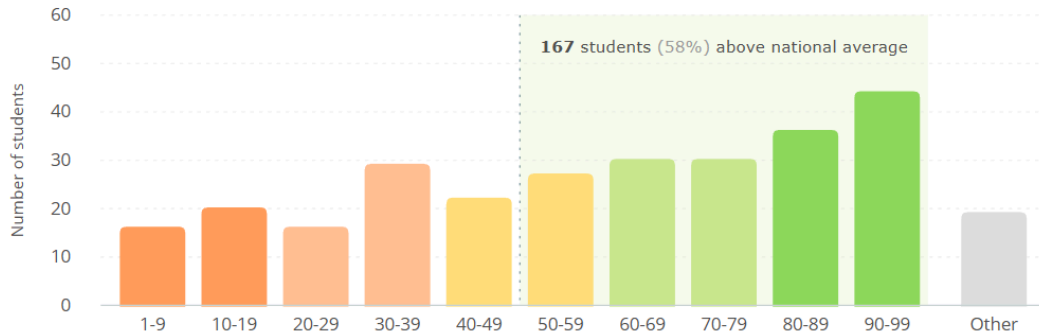

Percentile ranks



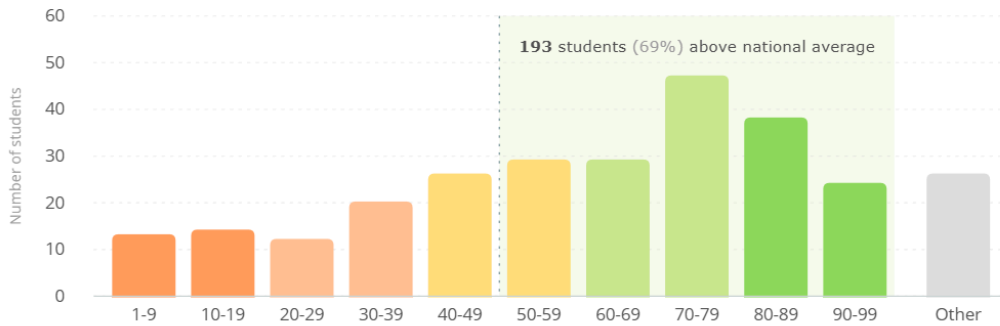

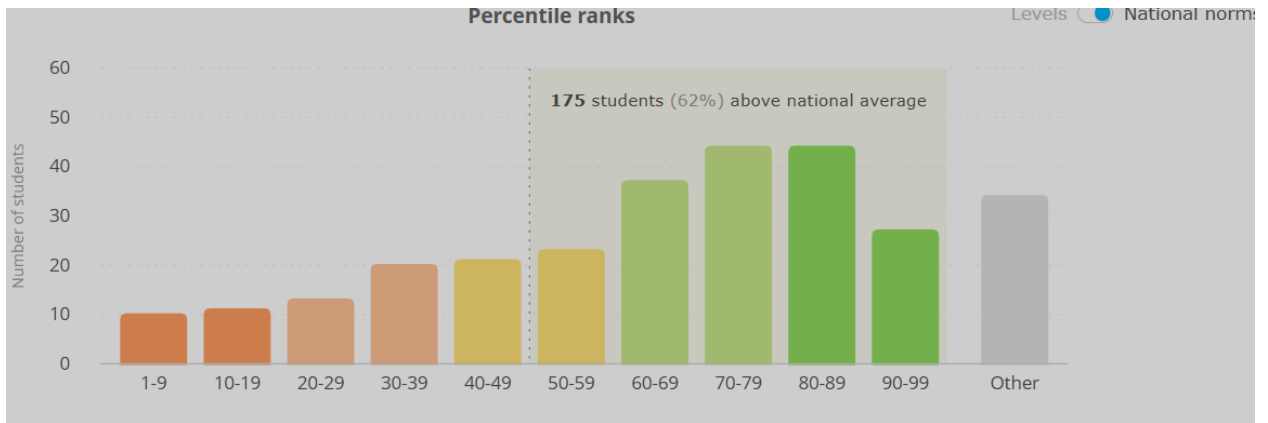


Noticings: More students are above the national average at 167 or 58% of our students.

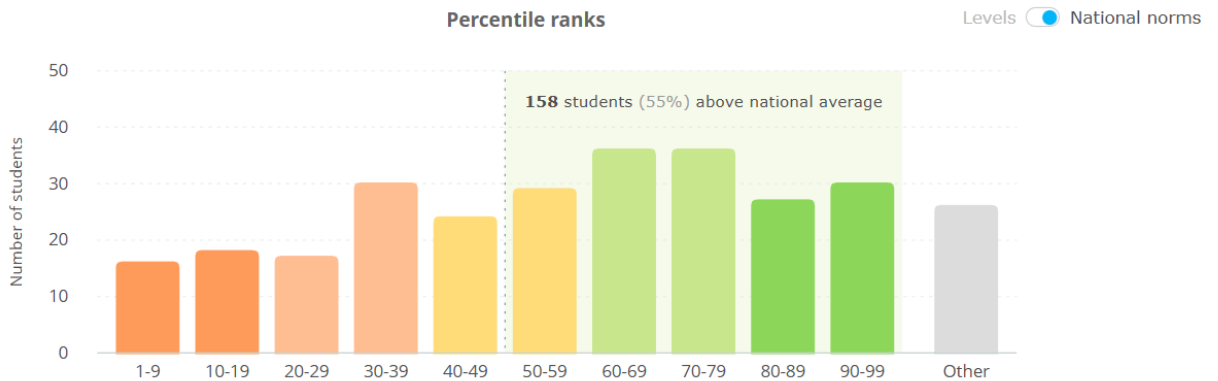
★ IXL Reading (2nd - 5th)

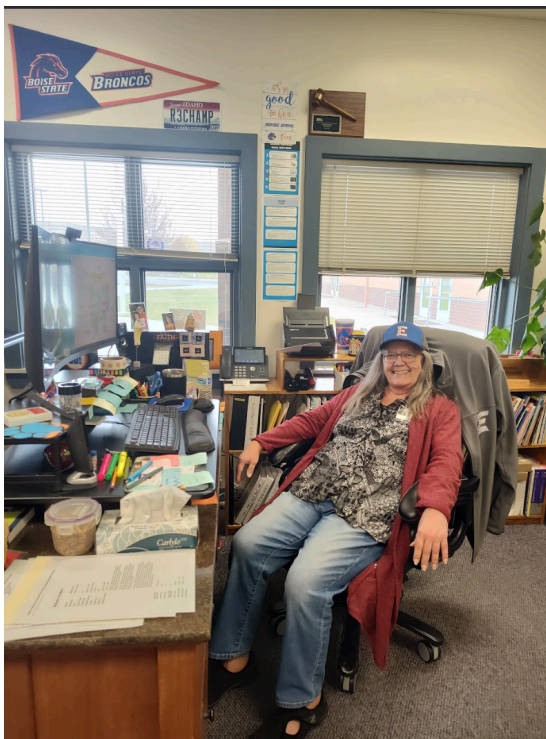
