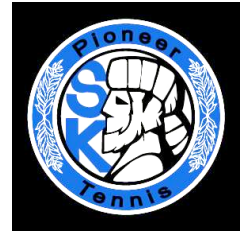


2026 Simon Kenton Youth Summer Tennis Camp
