Marking Periods:

- 1st – September 2 - November 4
- 2nd – November 5 - January 23
- 3rd – January 26 – April 1
- 4th – April 2 - June 11

Please note marking periods are subject to change due to inclement weather.

Graduation Date:

Graduation window is scheduled for May 28 – May 30

Early Dismissals

- Elementary students are dismissed early each Wednesday to provide planning and staff development time for teachers.
- All students will be dismissed early (secondary first, then elementary) on November 7, December 22-23, January 26, March 5, April 2 and May 1.
- All students will be dismissed early the last 3 days* of school.

* Official notification of these days at the end of the year and whether they will be scheduled as early dismissal will be determined as soon as possible after the inclement weather season.

Inclement Weather Make-up Days:

Inclement weather make-up days will be used in the following order:

- 1: May 22, 2026
- 2: April 8, 2026
- 3: April 7, 2026
- 4: June 12**, 2026

**If not used as inclement weather make-up day, schools will be closed for students; professional day for staff.

If the total number of days missed exceeds the designated number of inclement weather make-up days, then virtual education will be utilized at the end of the school year to satisfy state requirements.
