All pupils will need to purchase a school uniform through our supplier, Stevensons, or from any subsequent supplier nominated by the School.

### **Payment Options**

All fees will need to be settled on or before the start of term, unless an alternative payment arrangement is in place. Interest of 3% above the Bank of England base rate will be applied on a day-to-day basis for late payment with a minimum charge of £35.

In the event of late payment, the School reserves the right to charge a late payment administration fee of £250.

### **Scholarships and Bursaries**

Parents are reminded that any offer of scholarship or bursary support is subject to the remainder of all fees and extras being paid on time and in full, otherwise the award could be withdrawn. Policy documents are available on our website with details on how our fee award schemes operate.

If any parent is experiencing a change of circumstances, they are encouraged to contact the Finance and Operations Director who will advise on how we can assist parents.

### **Changes of Boarding Status**

A full term’s notice in writing to the Headmaster is required before a pupil’s boarding status can be changed for either school.

### **Withdrawal of pupils**

A full term’s notice in writing to the Headmaster is required before a pupil is removed from either school, failing which a full term’s fees are payable in lieu.

### **Loyalty Bonus**

The School now offers a loyalty bonus to those parents who decide to commit their children for a number of years to a Stonyhurst education. From September 2026, if your child progresses from Upper Elements (Year 6) into Figures (Year 7), a 2% discount will be applied each year to the fees for as long as your child remains continuously at Stonyhurst. If your child progresses from Syntax (Year 11) into Poetry (Year 12), a 3% discount will be applied each year to fees for the remainder of your child’s time at the School. This discount will be

cumulative so that if a pupil who started in Upper Elements or below stays into Higher Line a 5% fee remission discount will be applied to the fees for Poetry (Year 12) and Rhetoric (Year 13).

### **Sibling Discount**

In recognition of the incremental financial cost to families who wish to educate more than one of their children at Stonyhurst, the Governors have agreed a sliding scale of support as outlined below. This reduction of fees applies whilst the children are in attendance at the same time and will be adjusted appropriately as each sibling leaves.

- 1st child in attendance 0%
- 2nd child in attendance 5% reduction
- 3rd child in attendance 10% reduction
- 4th child in attendance 15% reduction

### **The Stonyhurst Association**
