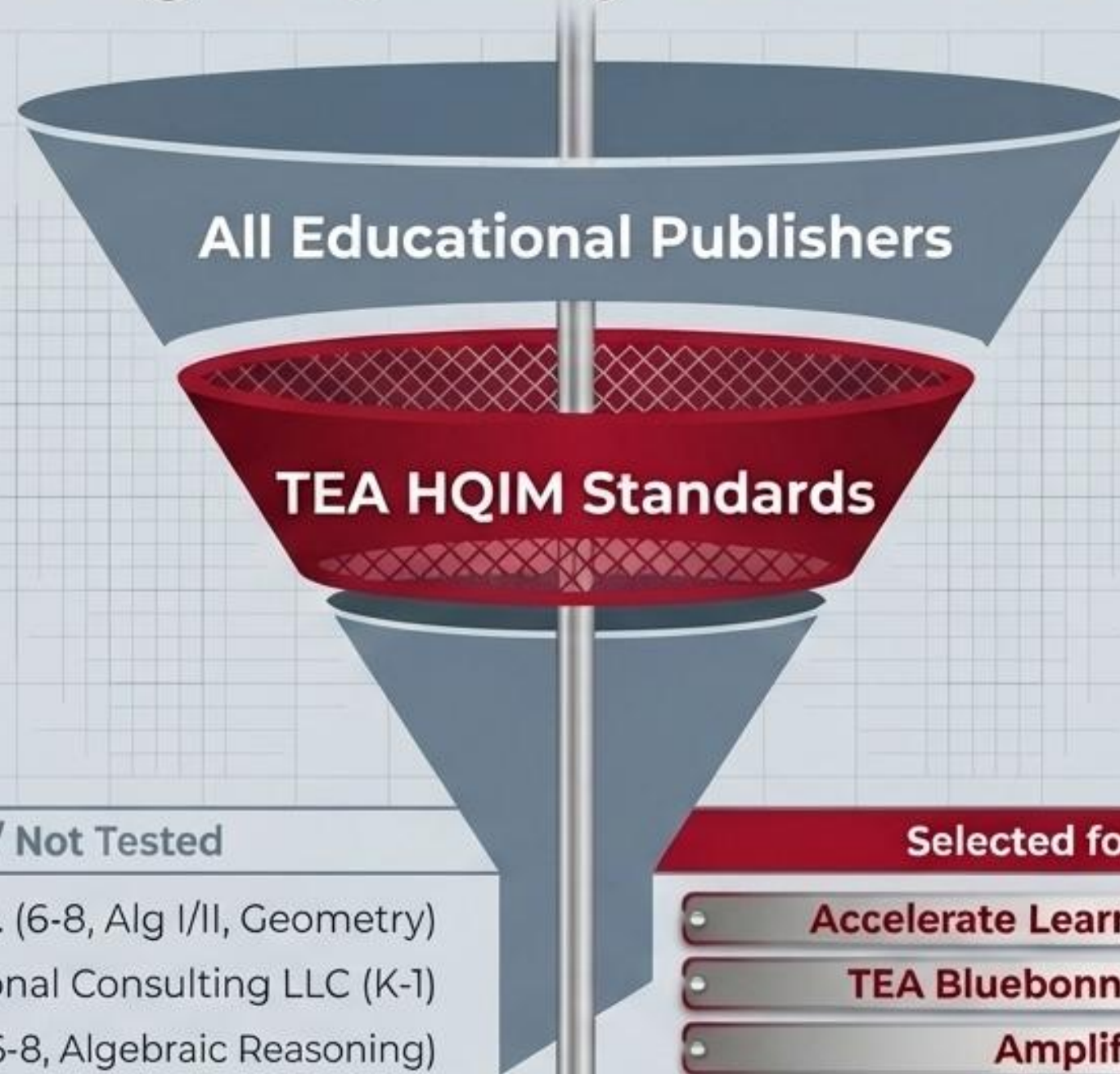

## Evaluate

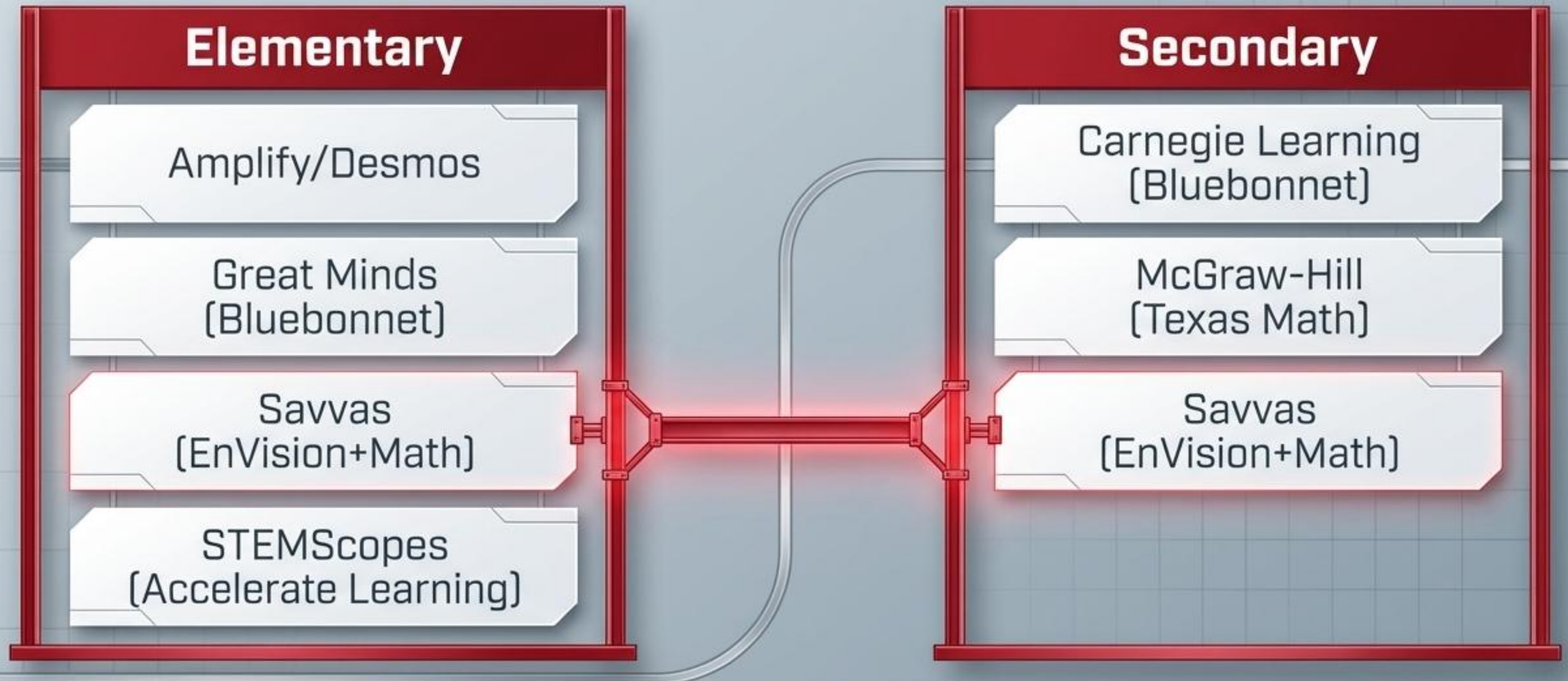
Campus teachers compile data and provide structured feedback to their designated campus representatives.

## Implement

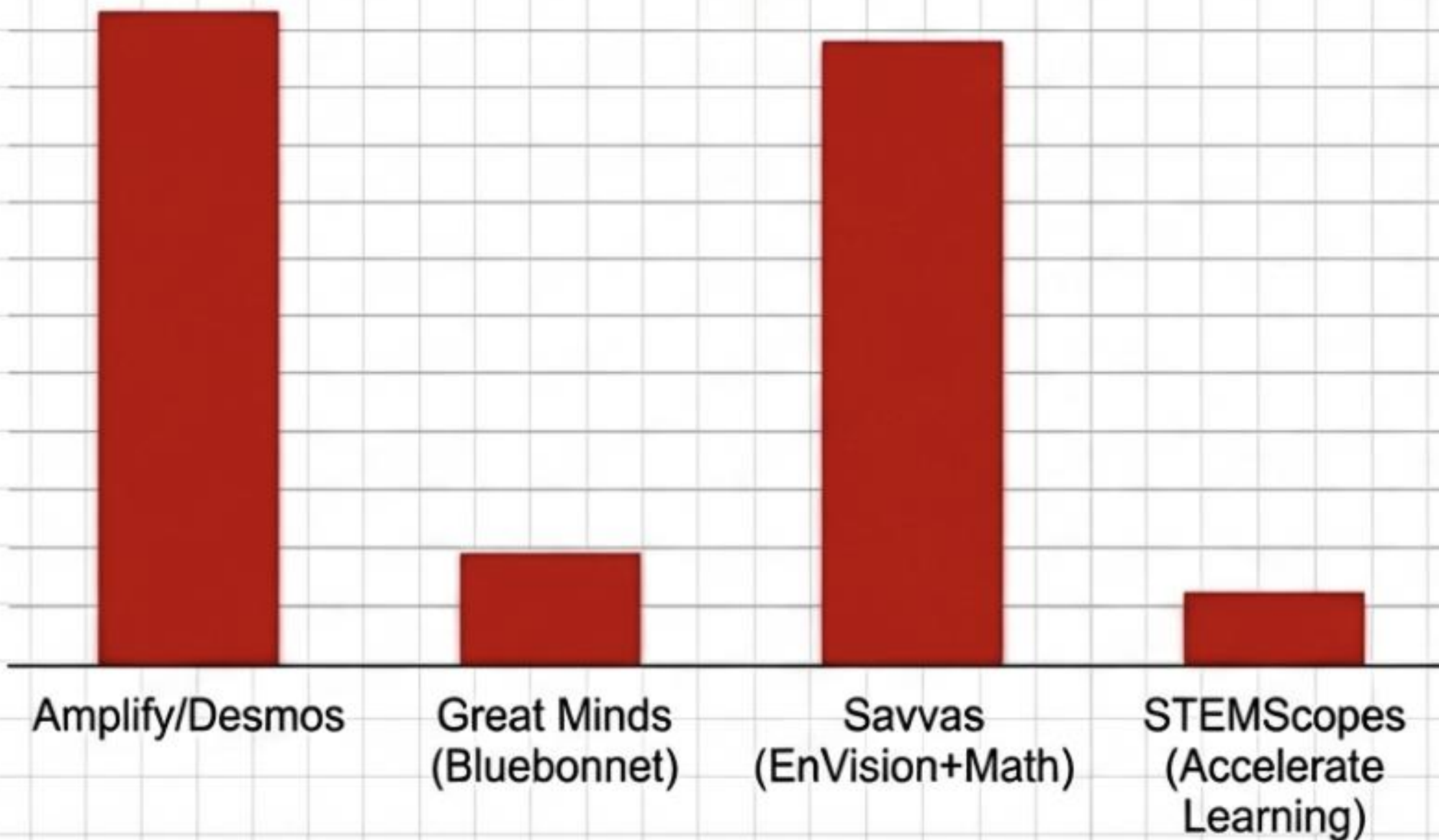
Teachers utilize the trial materials to actively plan and teach actual classroom lessons.

# Elementary educator feedback revealed a tight preference between two top-tier platforms.



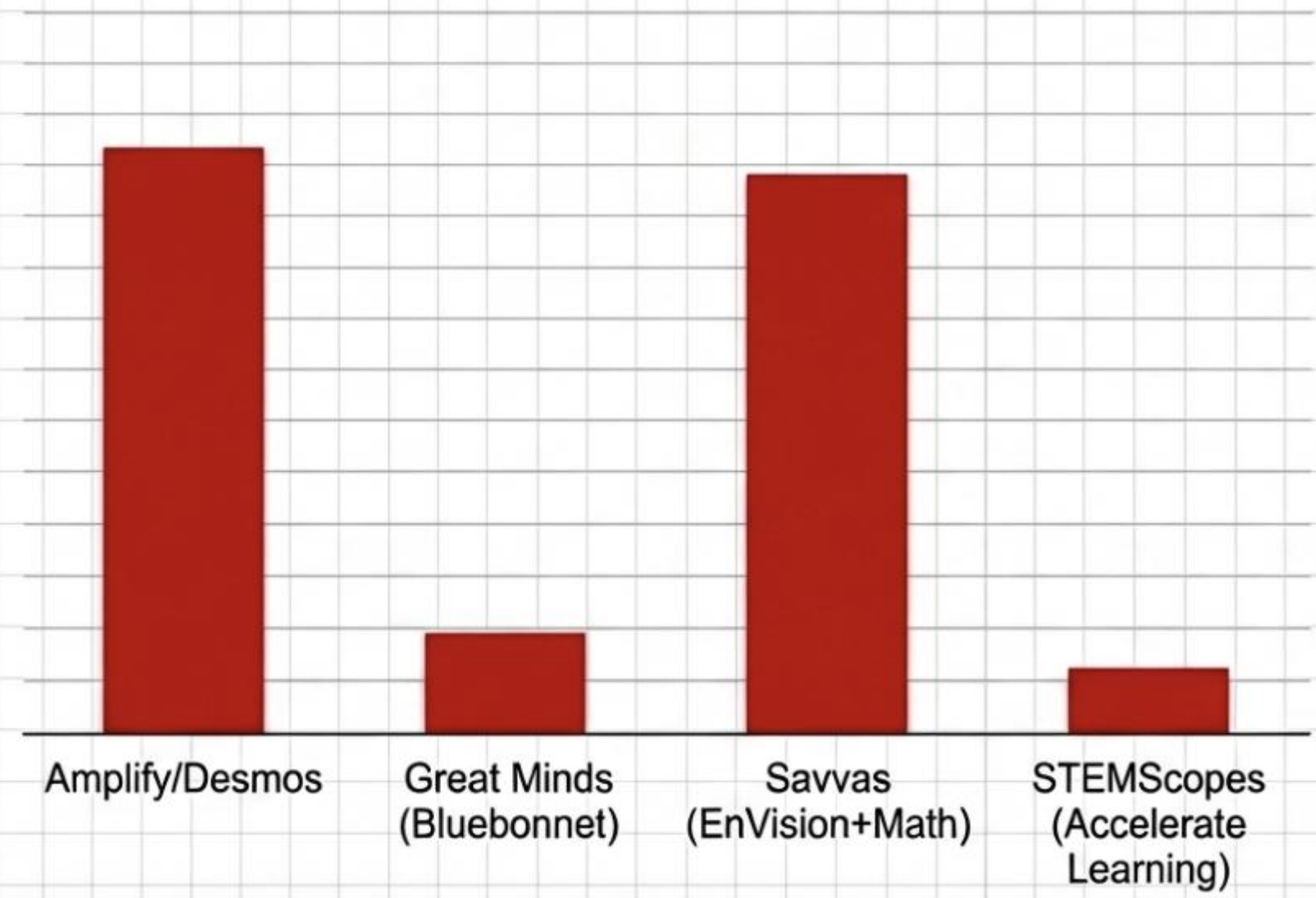
Both **Amplify** and **Savvas** demonstrated exceptional Tier-1 preference among elementary staff, with only **1 vote difference** as the top choice.

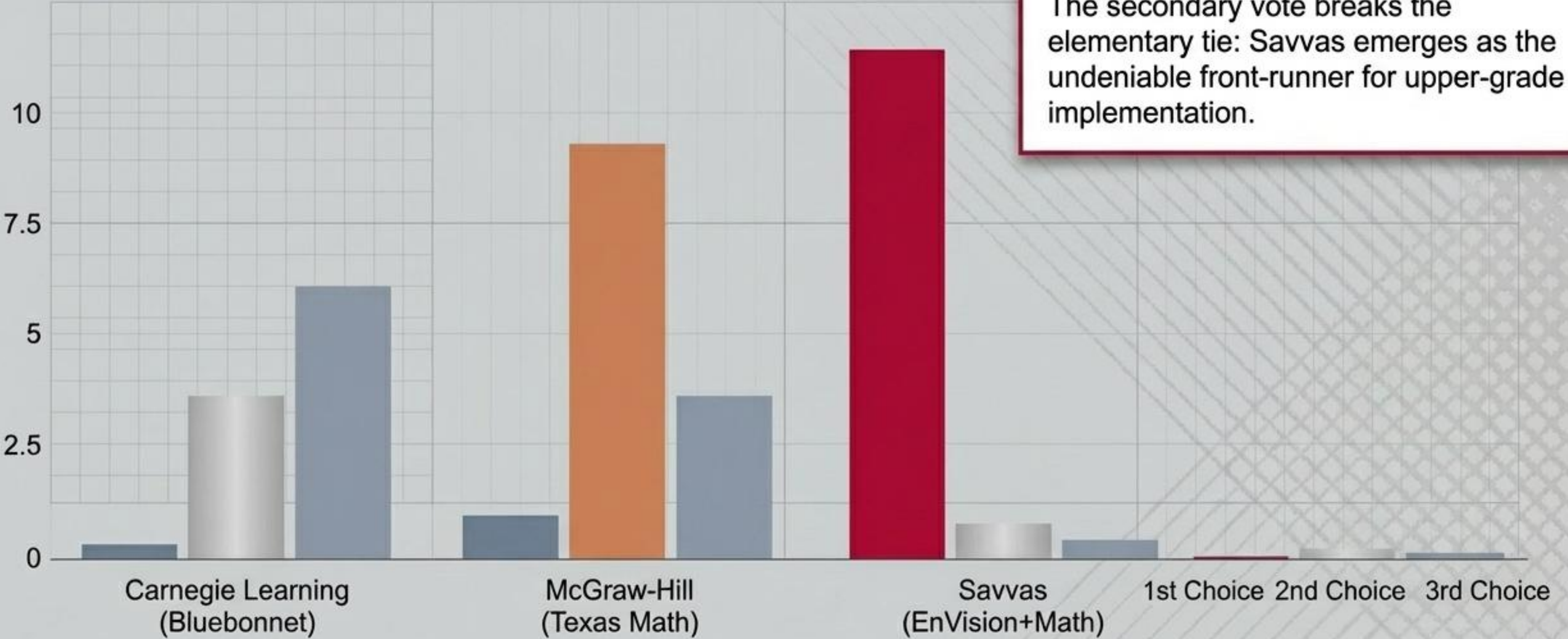

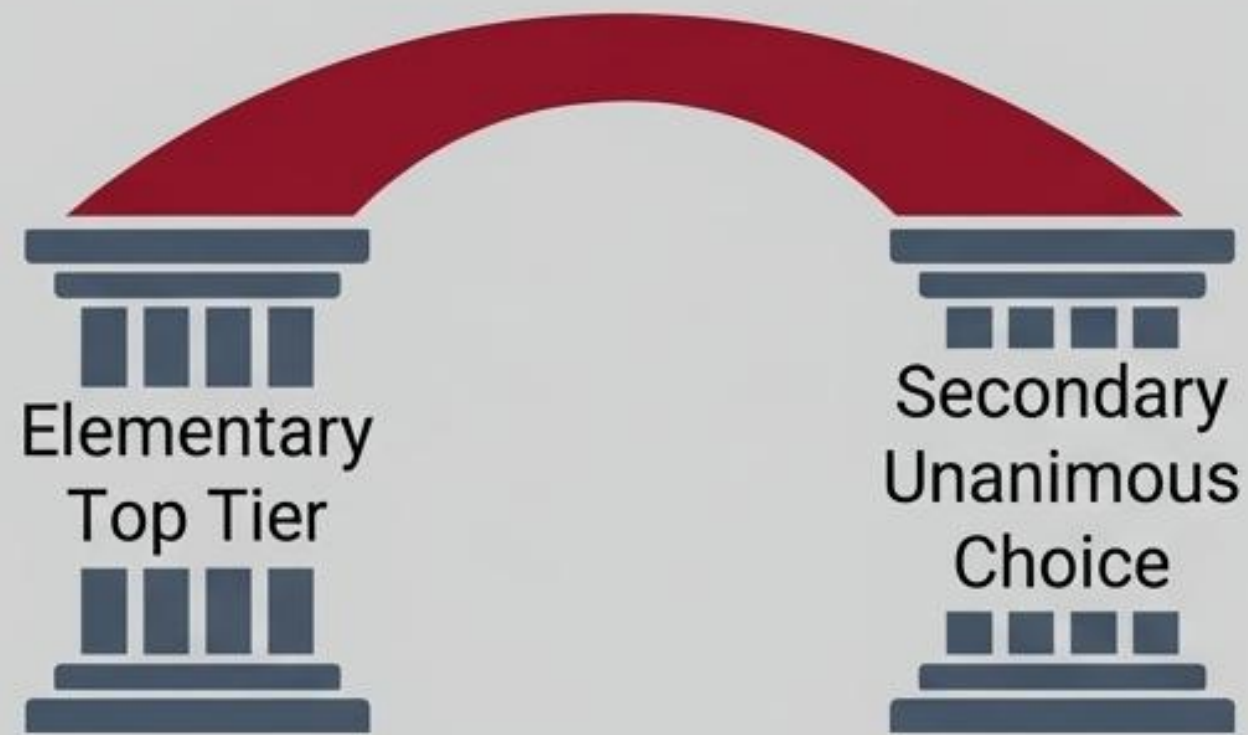
