### Year 13 End of Year Information

As we approach the last few weeks before the start of the A level exams we'd like to take this opportunity to update you with study arrangements for our Year 13 students and some key dates for you to be aware of.

#### Year 13 Leavers Day-Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May

-  On Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May we will be holding a celebration event for year 13.
-  The day will include a leavers assembly, giving out of yearbooks and hoodies, voting for prom awards, and a whole year group activity.
-  **Students will be dismissed at 12:00pm.**
-  Students who cannot drive or be collected can stay in school until buses leave, **please let us know via email if your child will be staying on site** until buses.

#### Leaver's Day Dress Up Theme

It is traditional for students to dress up for Leaver's Day in keeping with a theme. Dress-up Theme: British Icons & Childhood Throwbacks! **The outfit must be appropriate for a school setting.**

#### Study Leave Begins- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May

Students are only expected in school for lessons and examinations. Students are expected to attend all lessons until they have completed their final exam in that subject. Students can work at home at all other times. If students are reliant on buses or prefer to work in school, they are welcome to be in school all day.

#### Attendance Protocol for 11<sup>th</sup> May onwards:

If students are in school between **8:30-8:50am**, they go to their tutor room to be **registered by their tutor**

If students **arrive after 8:50am** they **MUST sign in at student services** on arrival

If students **leave before 2:45pm** they **MUST sign out at student services**

#### Exam Day Protocol:

On days students have an exam, they are not expected to attend lessons i.e. if an exam is in the afternoon, they have the morning off and visa versa.

Once students have finished their exams in a particular subject, they are not expected to attend the lessons, however those reliant on buses are more than welcome to stay in school all day to study.
