



## CLASS: 8- all year 8

These independent learning tasks should be completed by 15.05.2026. Pupils are expected to complete all tasks. All completed tasks will be rewarded with positive points.

### Reading

Pupils should spend 20 minutes, 4 times a week reading for pleasure. This can be a novel, magazine or any reading material that pupils enjoy.

#### Mathematics and numeracy

This half term will have a focus on sequences, ratio, proportion and numerical reasoning. Complete the task on Google Classroom looking at calculating the  $n^{\text{th}}$  term rule for a given sequence, sharing into a given ratio, recipe proportions and numerical reasoning.

#### English, literacy and communication

Create a questionnaire/survey to gather people's views on animal rights. Make sure to include a mixture of open and closed questions and cover all areas of the topic e.g. eating meat, keeping animals in captivity, wearing fur.

#### Science and technology

Independent learning task sheet has been uploaded onto the Google Classroom. For each row you complete you get an added two points to your total points which links to the leadership board. All work needs to be uploaded to the drive or put in the homework box to get your points.
