- Review of SHARE Program: PowerPoint presentation by Sarah Anderson from SHARE
 - A team of SHARE Instructors (men and women) come and teach a 50 minute class each day over the course of 3 days in a classroom setting
 - Class is divided by gender for certain discussions
 - Delivered in a classroom setting via PowerPoint presentations, videos, interactive discussions, games, and activities
 - Age appropriate instruction occurs on the following topics: abstinence, difficulties of teen pregnancy, healthy vs. unhealthy relationships and dating violence, peer pressure, STIs, media influence, sex in advertising, social media, and pornography, sex trafficking, sexting, and cyberbullying
 - Aligned with the Health TEKS; Meets Texas requirements for an abstinence-based curriculum
 - Schools must obtain written parental consent before providing human sexuality instruction to a student. Students will not be allowed to participate unless we receive written consent. Under Texas law, you may exempt your child from participating in any part of the district's human sexuality instruction. Your child's teacher will assign alternative lessons or activities. Your child will not be subject to any disciplinary action, academic penalty, or other sanction.
