School Fee's: All school fee's must be paid prior to purchasing prom ticket. Fee receipt must be presented at time of purchase; receipt can't be older than 5 days. See Ms. Muse (MAIN OFFICE)

Time: The doors will open at 7:30 pm. Prom Court must arrive prior to 8:30 pm. Dinner will be served promptly at 8:30 pm. You must arrive by 9:00 p.m. to ensure Prom entrance. After 9:00 p.m. students will not be allowed to enter. *No refunds will be given!* Prom ends at 11:30 p.m.

Parking: Street & Parking lot available on a first come first serve. Lot is located next door. Credit/ Debit Card payment accepted.

Entrance: TR Students must have their Prom ticket and ID with them. Their guests must also have a Photo ID. If you/your guest do not have your ID, you will not be allowed to enter. PICTURE OF THEIR I.D ARE ACCEPTABLE

No exceptions!

Prom Attire & behavior: If your attire is deemed unacceptable, and does not conform to the dress code, you will not be admitted into the Prom and a refund will NOT be issued. If you are unsure, please do not hesitate to show a photo to Ms. T beforehand. Any signs of illegals substance usage or alcohol will result in loss of entry with no refund.

THORNBRIDGE PROM ATTIRE GUIDELINES

THE PROM IS THE LAST DANCE FOR SENIORS AND IS THE CULMINATION OF FOUR YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL. THE PROM SHOULD BE LOOKED UPON AS A SHOWCASE OF ELEGANCE, STYLE, SOPHISTICATION, AND GOOD TASTE. KEEPING THIS IN MIND, A COMMITTEE OF FACULTY, PARENTS, AND STUDENTS HAVE MET AND PREPARED THE FOLLOWING PROM ATTIRE GUIDELINES FOR ALL STUDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS.

PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING:

If wearing a suit:

Suits must be an “after-five” tuxedo or formal wear

Gang Paraphernalia is prohibited

Head scarves are not allowed

Formal shoes must be worn (no gym shoes)

Gentlemen Trainers & Slippers are accepted

Formal hats are allowed – hats must be removed upon entry

If wearing a dress:

Dresses must be formal or “after-five” evening gown

High waist two pieces must be approved By Ms. T

Bare skin cannot be exposed around the upper thighs & genitals: Fabric only lace or mesh

“Cut-outs:” are not permitted

Sheer mesh coverings over “cut-outs” are permitted with approval

Cleavage area must be covered if lower than breastplate (example. Plunging neckline)

Splits cannot be higher than 3 inches (3”) above the knee.

Wearing form fitting jumpsuits, cat suits, and body suits will not be permitted

Shawls, jackets, wraps, or any other coverings cannot be worn over attire that does not meet these guidelines

Safety pins will not be allowed to correct inappropriate attire

- Thornridge students and/or their guests who do not comply with the above guidelines **will not be admitted** to the prom.
- Students not admitted due to their attire **will not receive a refund.**
- Those students or guests who alter their attire after being admitted to the prom will be escorted from the event and **will not receive a refund.**

THORNBRIDGE STAFF MEMBERS WILL BE AT THE DOOR TO ENSURE THAT THE PROM GUIDELINES ARE FOLLOWED. THORNBRIDGE STAFF RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE ADMITTANCE FOR INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE. STUDENTS WHO PURCHASE TICKETS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FOLLOWING THE DRESS CODE DESCRIBED IN THIS BULLETIN AND ALSO COMMUNICATING THIS INFORMATION TO THEIR DATES.
