The virtual meeting opening with the reading of the minutes from the previous meeting. The minutes were read and a motion was made to receive the minutes as read.

From the Principal's report: Mr. Richardson informed the council that retention letters will be sent home to parents tomorrow, February 13th. He explained the purpose of the letters is to let parents know where scholars stand. Teachers will schedule conferences with the parents of scholars who received letters to discuss the next steps to better support students to earn what they need to get to the next grade level. Intercession is coming up next week, then afterwards we will fast forward to i-Ready testing which is coming at the end of March.



Incentives will be given to scholars who meet their goal and those plans are being finalized. Lastly, parents have had concerns about some of the assessments that have been given, stating that they are very rigorous. Mr. Richardson wanted parents to understand that we must make sure we are teaching to the extent of the State Standards and they we are testing as such, if not this means we are not covering those standards when teaching and assessing, nor prepping them for their next grade level and/or standardized test.

The Parent Liaison reviewed the Kids Heart Challenge campaign agenda including online giving continuing as well as a fundraiser afterschool dance to be held tonight at 5:00pm to 7:00pm. The campaign ends on February 27th.
